WHEREAS, in Washington State any school district over 2,000 pupils or more is a school district of the first class; and

WHEREAS, in Washington State any school district under 2,000 pupils is a school district of the second class; and

WHEREAS, there are approximately 295 school districts in Washington State; and

WHEREAS, there are approximately 95 first class districts in Washington State; and

WHEREAS, there are approximately 200 second class districts in Washington State; and

WHEREAS, decisions and advocacy made by WSSDA impacts every school district; and

WHEREAS, article XI Section 3 if the WSSDA bylaws includes the following language for a weighted vote during general assembly; "When a weighted vote is called, delegates shall receive the number of votes as set forth in a vote chart based on student enrollment on the first school day in October."

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Directors of the Woodland School District does hereby move to remove Article XI Section 3 titled Weighted vote from the WSSDA bylaws.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLOVED that Article XI section 2 item E be revised to state only, "Every delegate shall have one vote."
