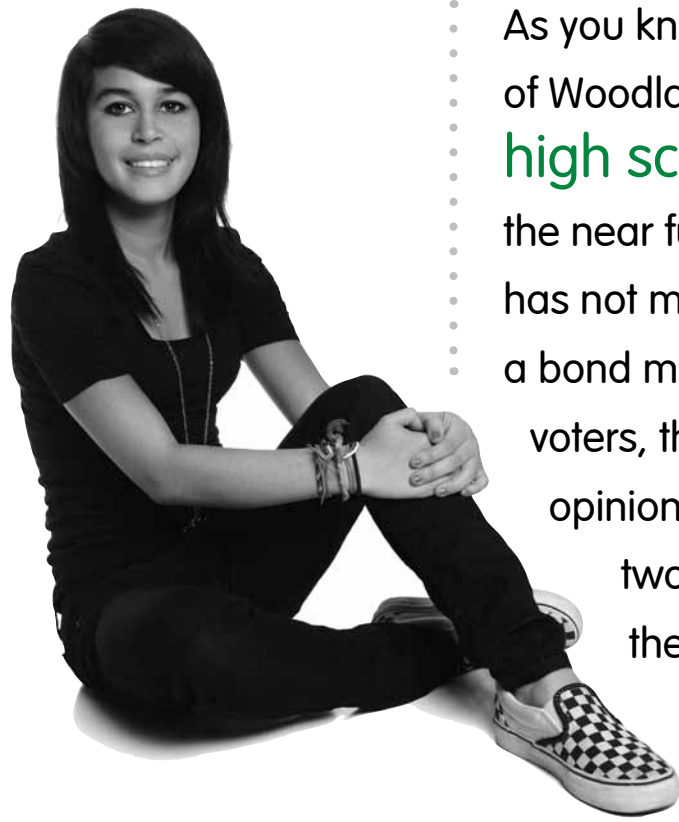

Although the board has not made a decision as to when a bond measure might go before voters, they would like to hear your opinion on which of the following two sites you think would make the best choice. Please read the following information about each site and then indicate which site you believe is best suited for a new high school.

### Dike Access Road Site

Development Time: 48 months • Cost estimate: \$57.95 million

#### PROS »

- Continued use of existing school bus facility
- Expansion room for additional buildings
- Possible cost-sharing with neighboring properties under construction

#### CONS »

- On-site wetlands require mitigation and additional scrutiny during construction which increase costs
- Requires more extensive off-site road and frontage improvements than existing campus
- Will probably require surcharging and mass grading
- Requires transportation or bell schedule modification which generate additional operating costs

### Current Site

Development Time: 42 months • Cost estimate: \$55.8 million

#### PROS »

- Allows for the option to reuse certain existing facilities such as performing arts center, track, fields and parking
- Probably no wetland mitigation or additional surcharging and mass-grading
- No modification to transportation system or bell schedules

#### CONS »

- Requires the construction/relocation of the school bus facility
- Less space for future expansion as schools grow in size
- May require replacement of 1 or 2 existing sewer pump stations
