Dike Access Road Site

Estimated Development Time: 48 months • 2008 cost estimate: \$57.95 million

PROS »

- Space for future expansion as Woodland grows
- Possible cost-sharing with neighboring properties under construction
- Traffic flow for students, staff, and visitors improved over current site

CONS »

- Wetlands on site will require mitigation
- Extensive site preparation will be necessary
- Will require more extensive off-site road and frontage improvements than the current site

Current Site

Estimated Development Time: 42 months • 2008 cost estimate: \$55.8 million

PROS »

- Allows for the option to reuse and shared use of some existing facilities
- Potential for lower operating costs because of fewer grounds to maintain
- Will likely require no wetland mitigation or extensive site preparation.

CONS »

- No space for future expansion as Woodland grows
- May require relocation of current KWRL bus facility
- May require replacement of 1 or 2 existing sewer pump stations
