
Nearly ALL indicators show a DECREASE in students claiming to be bullied and harassed (Questions 1-7, 14-28)
























































26) Has someone hurt or harassed you on the phone?









ALL indicators show an INCREASE in student perceptions of bullying and harassment (Questions 8-11)




9) How often do you think students bully of harass other students in our school?







11) Do you think staff (teachers, coaches, aides, etc.) are effective at stopping bullying/harassment in school?




One Indicator show a DECREASE in student perceptions of effective adult intervention (Question 29)






One Indicators shows that students are more likely to tell teachers and the principal of bullying and less likely to tell friends, parents, counselors, siblings, clergy, or police.





Values on the use of defensive violence have changed








How students gain information about rules has changed modestly
