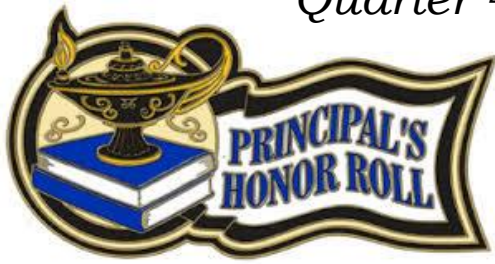

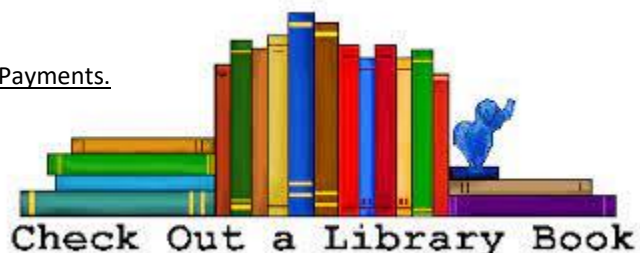
FVRL Summer Reading
