## **HOLIDAYS**

The district shall observe the following school holidays and shall not operate on these days: New Year's Day (January 1, Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (third Monday in January), President's Day (third Monday in February), Memorial Day (last Monday in May), Independence Day (July 4), Labor Day (first Monday in September), Veteran's Day (November 11), Thanksgiving Day (fourth Thursday in November), the day after Thanksgiving, the day before Christmas (December 24), and Christmas Day (December 25), and the day before New Years Day (December 31). Whenever any legal holiday falls on Sunday, the following Monday shall be a legal holiday, and whenever any legal holiday falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be a legal holiday. In years when New Years Day falls on a Saturday the observance of the day before New Years (December 31) shall be on the Thursday preceding December 31 (December 30)

In addition to the above the following shall also be considered to be holidays: the day before Christmas and the day before New Years Day (December 24 and December 31)
