HOLIDAYS

The district shall observe the following school holidays and shall not operate on these days: New Year's Day (January 1), Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (third Monday in January), President's Day (third Monday in February), Memorial Day (last Monday in May), Independence Day (July 4), Labor Day (first Monday in September), Veteran's Day (November 11), Thanksgiving Day (fourth Thursday in November), the day after Thanksgiving, the day before Christmas (December 24), Christmas Day (December 25), and the day before New Year's Day (December 31). Whenever any legal holiday falls on Sunday, the following Monday shall be a legal holiday, and whenever any legal holiday falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be a legal holiday.

In years when New Year's Day and Christmas Day fall on Saturdays the holidays shall be observed on December 24th (Christmas Eve), December 27th (Christmas Day), December 30th (New Year's Eve) and December 31st (New Year's Day)
