



HYS STUDENT PARTICIPATION




- 128 (74%) Grade 6 students

- 99 (63%) Grade 12 students





CHANGE OVER TIME: BULLYING






FIGHTING: Decrease by 10% the percentage of students who report being in a physical fight at school (GPRA)







CHANGE OVER TIME: MARIJUANA




COHORT CHANGE: MARIJUANA




ALCOHOL USE: Decrease by 5% the percentage of students who report past 30-day use (GPRA)
