Dear Woodland City Council Members,

The Board of Directors stands in support of a joint grant application between the Woodland School District and the City of Woodland for WSDOT Safe Routes to School funding.

The proposed project would 1) fill sidewalk gaps on the west side of South Pekin Drive, 2) improve an intersection at Davidson Avenue and 5th Street, and 3) implement an educational or enforcement component such as a Walking School Bus or crossing guard program. The intent of the proposed project is to increase the number of children safely traveling to school to the Woodland Elementary and Middle Schools.

If grant funds are awarded and accepted, the City would be the lead agency and project manager. The School District would be responsible for implementing any proposed education or enforcement improvement and for conducting the required student surveys. The Board understands that an application for grant funds is not a commitment to accept funds if Woodland is successful in its application.
