Our original price was \$991,500 for 2344 Geopier elements. After subtracting out our mobilization cost of \$30,000 the cost per Geopier element is \$410. The added areas have increased the Geopier count by 129 Geopier elements. We are requesting a change order of $$410 \times 129 = $52,890$ for the additional areas. This cost does not include any additional cost for a performance bond. Also, the additional Geopier elements will add approximately 4 to 5 working days to the schedule.
