 What is the best use for existing facilities space once the new High School opens?

- 4 Considerations:
 - Educational Programs
 - Enrollment Projections
 - Capacity & Utilization
 - Condition of Facilities

Educational Programs

- Basic education : language arts, mathematics, social studies, science
- Electives: music, art, PE, computer skills, library services
- Design Space, Adapted Space, Shared Space, or No Space

Enrollment Projections

- WOODLAND
 Public Schools
 Excellence In Education
- Big Factors: Historical data & Percentage of growth
- Observed enrollment over the last six years



• Anticipating *flat enrollment* or a *slight* increase.



 Consulting team chose to plan for "minimum" level of facilities to house students.

Capacity & Utilization

- Four Factors:
 - Physical size of instructional space
 - Class size limits
 - Schedule of use
 - Programs offered

Condition of Facilities

- Evaluated educational adequacy of each space:
 - sizes, adjacencies, utilities, other feature programs
- Physical assessment of each school facility:
 - Exteriors, interiors, mechanical systems, safety

Space Use Scenario 1

- PreK-3 school at existing Primary and Intermediate Schools
- All grades 4-6 housed in existing Middle School
- All grades 7-8 housed in existing High School

Space Use Scenario 2

- Grade 1-5 school at both Primary and Intermediate
- PreK-K housed in some of the existing Middle School
- Grades 6-8 throughout existing Middle and High Schools

- PreK-4 school at both existing Primary & Intermediate Schools
- New grade 5-8 Middle School established
- 5-6 housed in existing Middle School space
- 7-8 housed in existing High School space
