The purposes of this agreement are to utilize an inter-district cooperative, as authorized by RCW 28A.225.250 in order to provide an educational program not otherwise available and to avoid duplication of specialized programs and facilities. The objective of the Fire Science course is to provide an introductory fire science training class which will prepare students for careers in Fire Science and related fields. This course is linked to the Fire Science Program at Lower Columbia College and will provide opportunities for continued education.

The cooperative will serve an approximate amount of students as agreed upon below:

- Castle Rock School District: 1 to 5 students
- Kalama School District: 1 to 3 students
- Longview School District: 4 to 8 students
- Winlock School District: 1 to 3 students

Each student will be counted as a .4 FTE for enrollment reporting through the Kelso School District. Transportation for the students is the individual responsibility of the student.

Any student requiring specialized instruction to be successful in the Fire Science classroom will be the responsibility of the student's resident district. Kelso School District will be responsible for the attendance and grade reports for the Fire Science Class. All state required assessments will be the responsibility of the student's resident district. The costs to operate this cooperative program for the 2015-2016 school year will be funded from State and or Federal sources and paid by the serving district.
