## LEGAL STATUS AND OPERATION

## Legal Status

The board of directors of the Woodland School District is the corporate entity established by the state of Washington to plan and direct all aspects of the district's operations to <u>ensure quality in the content of the district's</u> <u>educational program and provide<del>end that</del> students with an opportunityshall have ample opportunity to achieve those skills recognized as requisite to their individual and collective learning needs.</u>

The policies of the board define the organization of the board and <u>its</u>the manner of conducting its official business. The board's operating policies are those that the board adopts from time to time to facilitate the performance of its responsibilities. Policies shall continue from year to year and board to board until and unless the board changes them.

## **Organization**

The corporate name of this school district is Woodland School District No. 404, Cowlitz and Clark Counties, state of Washington. The district is classified as a second first class district and is operated in accordance with the laws and regulations pertaining to second first class districts.

In order to achieve its <u>vision that in partnership with families and the community creating a PreK-12 system tha</u> <u>serves and supports all children— and ensures that each child has full access to, is engaged in, and obtains an</u> <u>excellent education that prepares them for responsible citizenship and a future of adaptability and success in life and</u> <u>their chosen endeavors, primary goal of providing each child with the necessary skills and attitudes, commensurate</u> with his/her ability, to become effective citizens, the board <u>willshall</u> exercise the full authority granted to it by the laws of the state. Its legal powers, duties and responsibilities are derived from state statute and regulation. Sources such as the school code (<u>Title 28A RCW</u>), (<u>Title 28A RCW</u>), attorney general's opinions, <u>regulations-and regulations</u> of the <u>State Board</u> of <u>Education (Title 180 WAC</u>), <u>education (Title 180 WAC</u>) and the <u>State</u> <u>Superintendent</u> state superintendent of <u>Public Instruction (Title 392 WAC</u>) public instruction (<u>Title 392 WAC</u>) delineate the legal powers, duties, and responsibilities of the board.

## Number of Members and Terms of Office

The board <u>willshall</u> consist of five members, elected by ballot by the registered voters of the district. Except as otherwise provided by law, board members <u>willshall</u> hold office for terms of four years and until their successors are elected and qualified. Terms of board members <u>willshall</u> be staggered as provided by law.

Newly--elected directors <u>willshall</u> take office at the first official meeting of the board of directors after the election results have been certified by the county auditor. Prior to beginning their term, directors <u>willshall</u> take and subscribe to an oath of office.

Student Liaison to the Board

One (1) high school student, selected by the ASB officers, current student liaison and advisor in May will officially represent students with the board. The term of office will be June 1 through May 31.

The student representative will be free to participate in all actions and activities of the board except the following:

B. Executive Sessions

The student representative shall receive the normal background information provided the other board members as appropriate.
