# **Establishing Performance Targets for Woodland Public Schools**

Whereas, the Woodland Public Schools Board of Directors has adopted a vision for the future of Woodland Public Schools which is: Woodland Public Schools, in partnership with families and the community, will create a PreK-12 system that serves and supports ALL children-and ensures that EACH child has FULL access to, is engaged in, and obtains an excellent education that prepares them for responsible citizenship and a future of adaptability and success in life and their chosen endeavors; and,

Whereas, an important part of preparing students for success is tied to their attainment of high educational standards and successful graduation from high school; now, therefore,

We establish, by resolution, the following performance targets:

#### **Graduation Rate:**

By 2021 the overall district four-year graduation rate will be at or above 85% By 2022 the overall district five-year graduation rate will be at or above 90%

### **School Attendance:**

By 2020 the rate of chronic absenteeism, defined as missing more than 18 school days, will be no greater than 10%.

### **Student Proficiency on Mandated Assessments:**

By 2022 80% of students will meet standard on mandated measures in Mathematics and English Language Arts at all grade levels. Student Performance will improve year-over-year <u>and</u> will exceed that of demographically similar school districts.

### **Student Growth on Mandated Assessments:**

Student growth percentiles in ELA and Math will exceed 50 in each grade level

### **High School Course Failure:**

Beginning in 2017-2018 High School freshman course failure (first attempt) will be below 10% for Core Classes (Math, English & Science)
