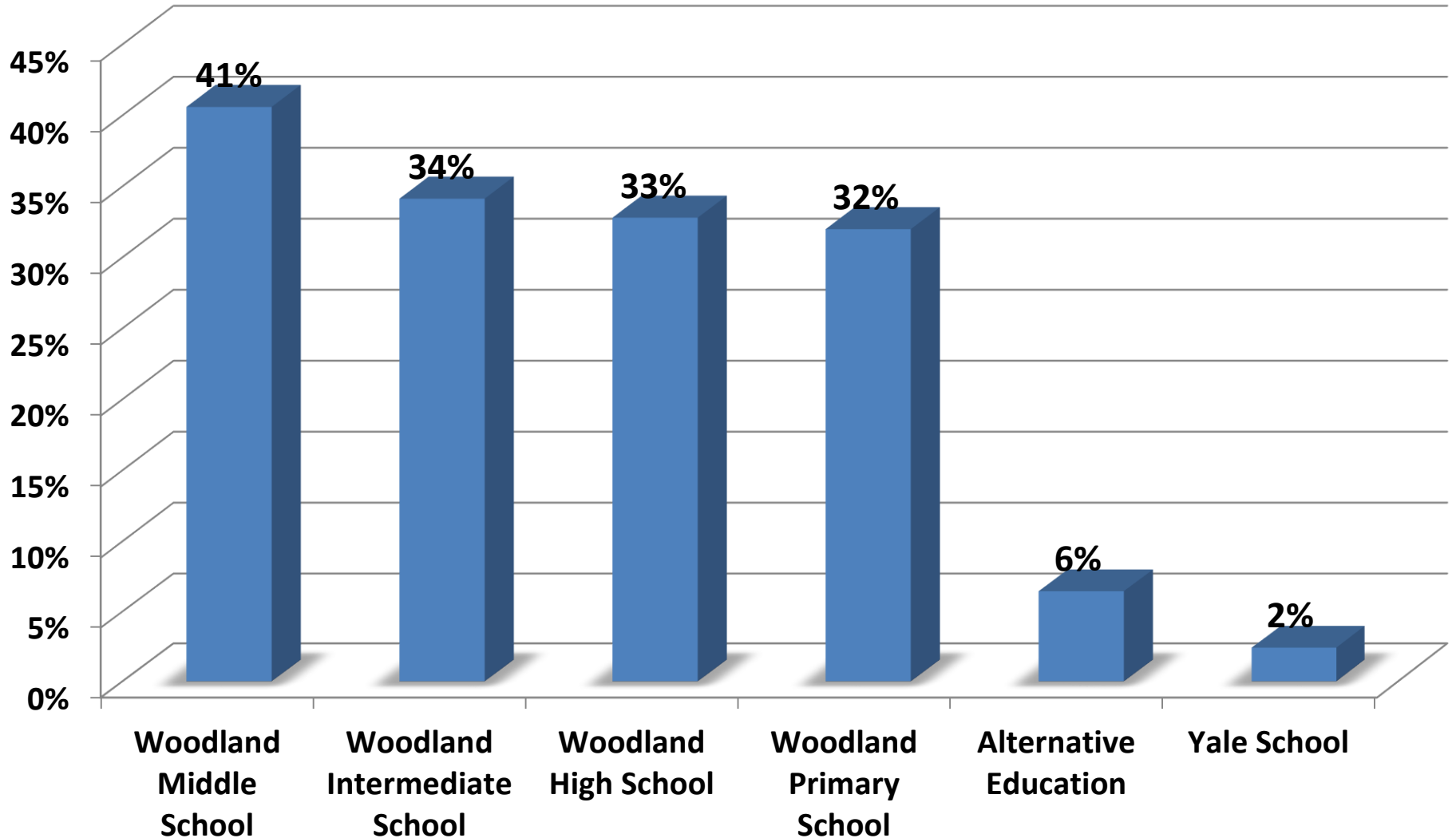

Survey Summary

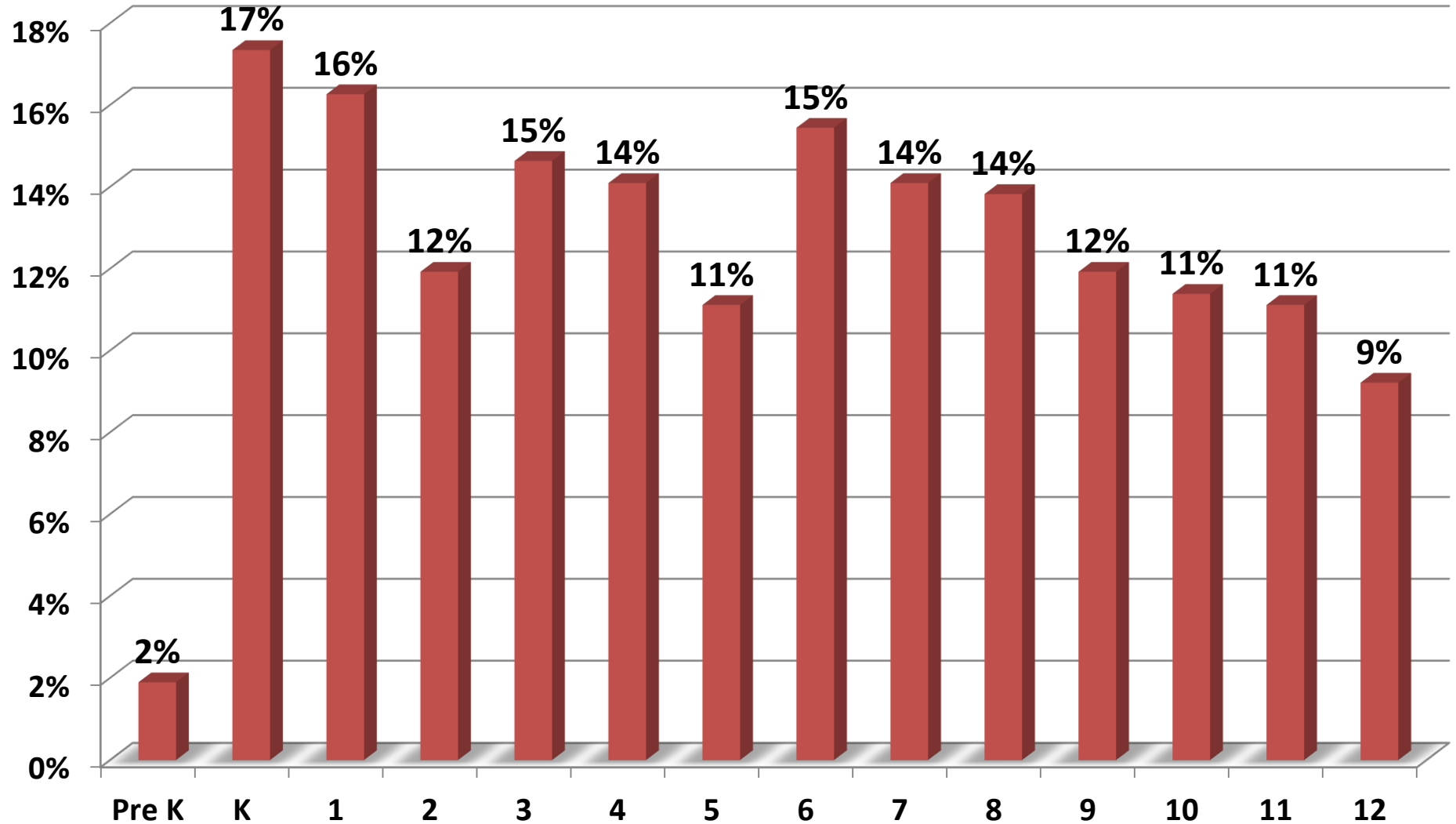
- Survey conducted in April of 2017

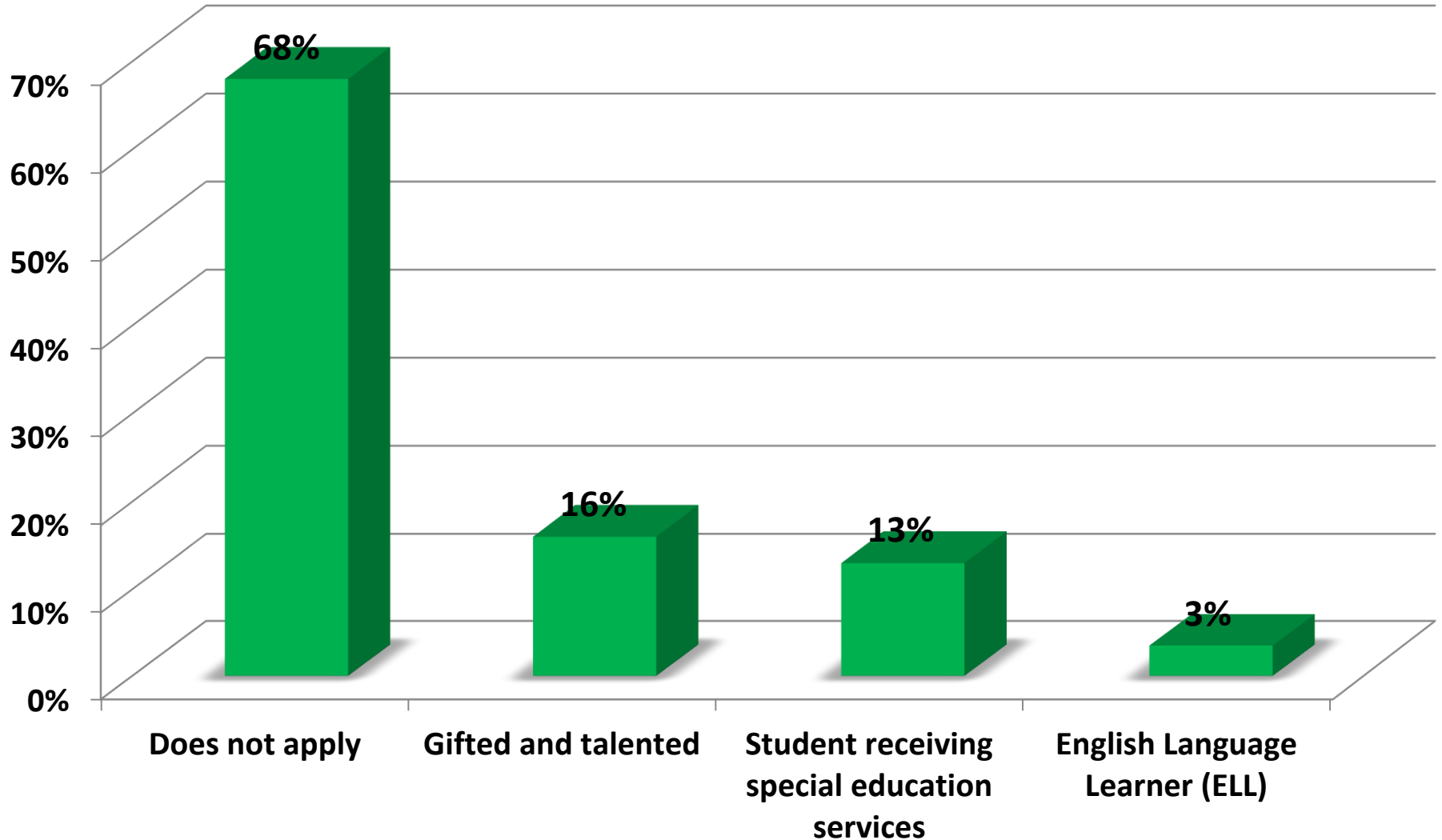
Which schools do your children attend?



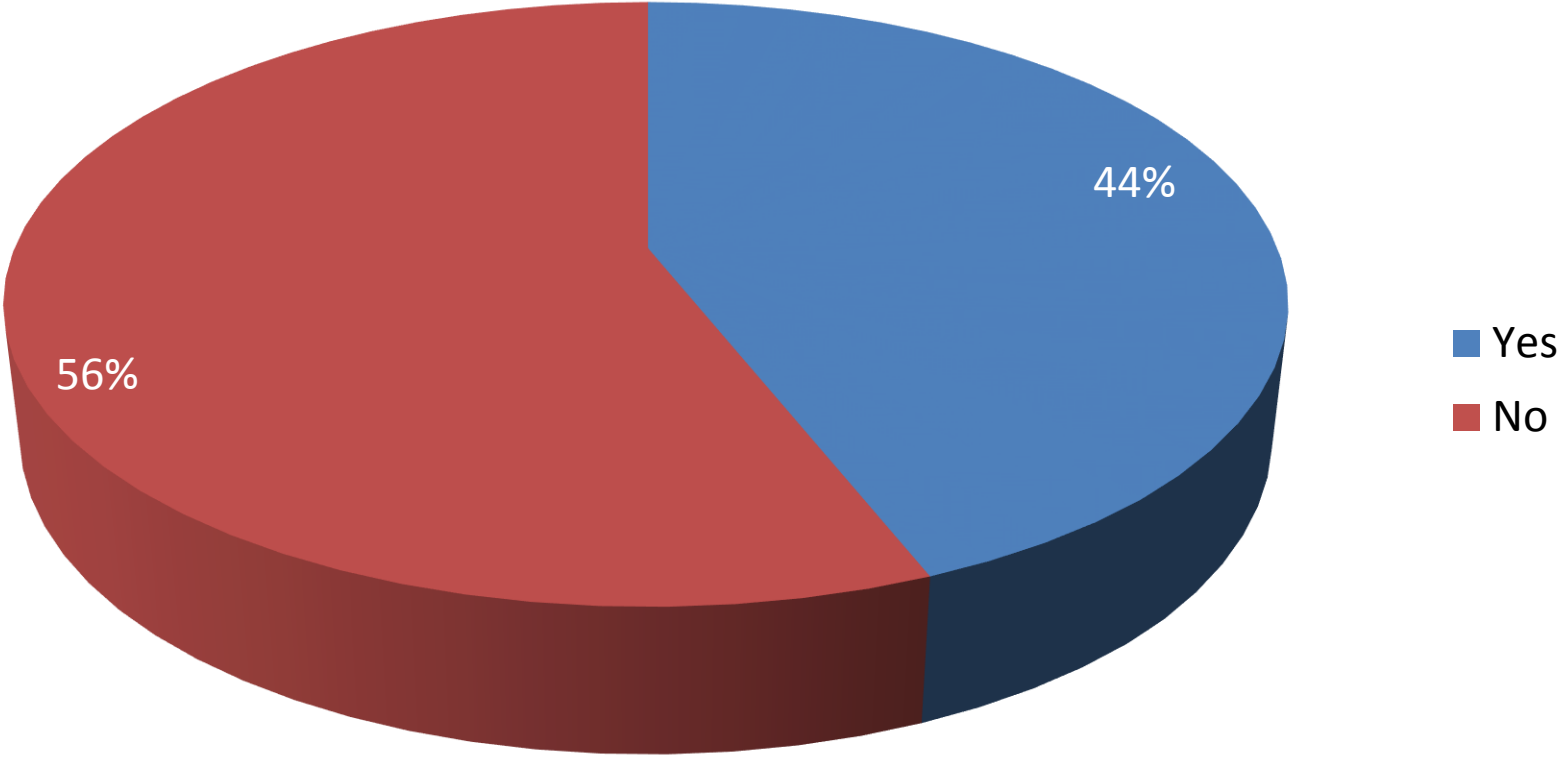
Grade level of your child(ren):



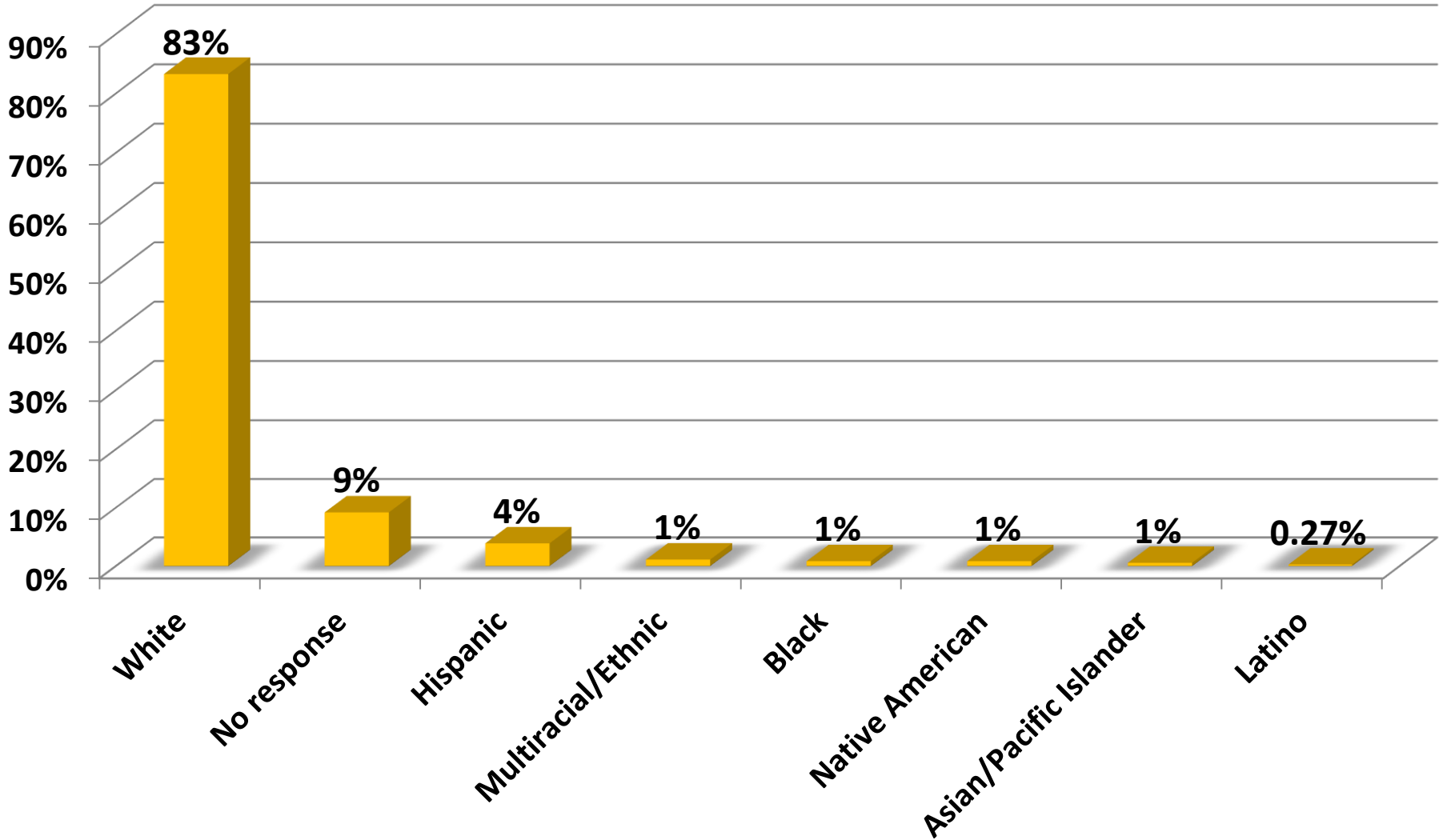

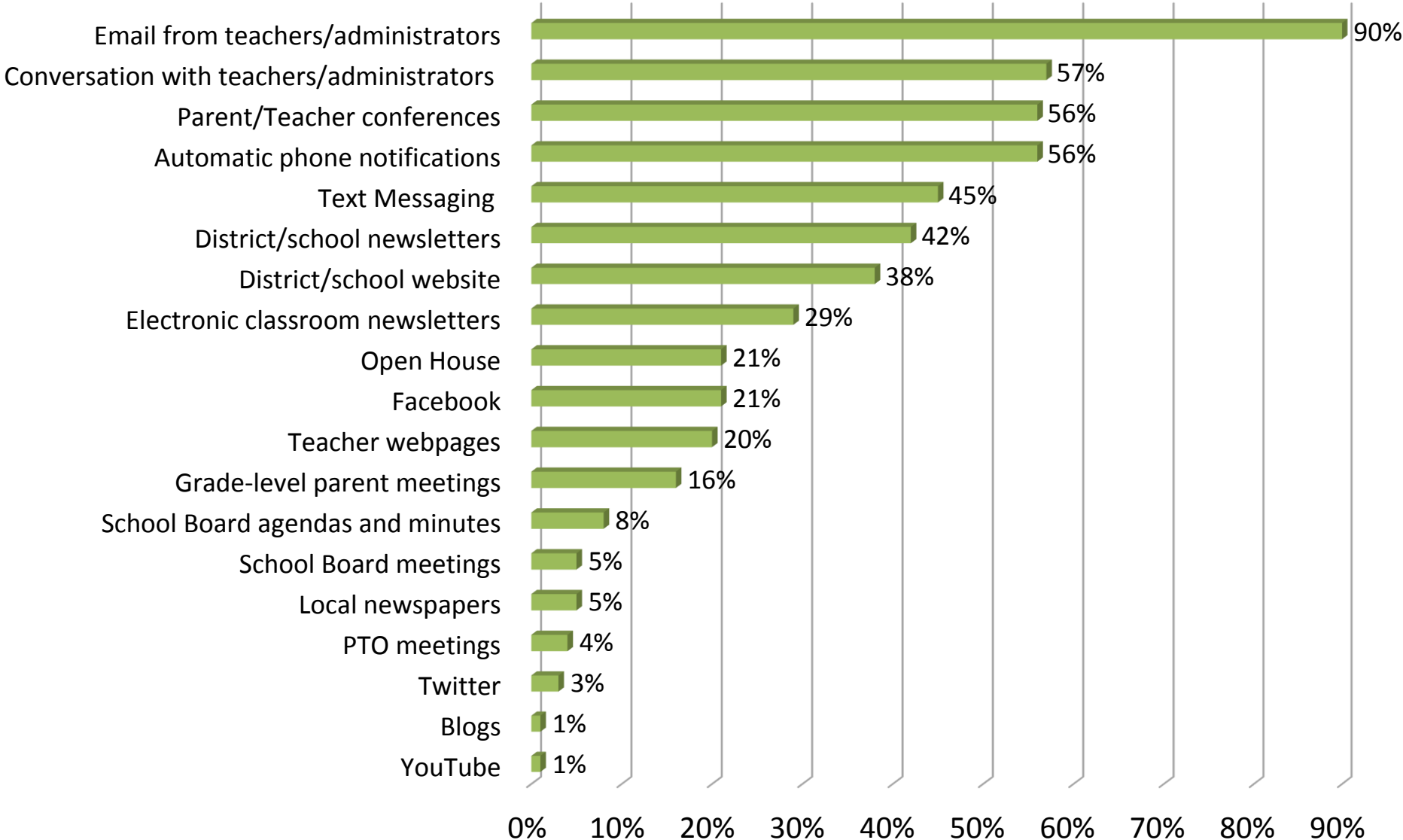

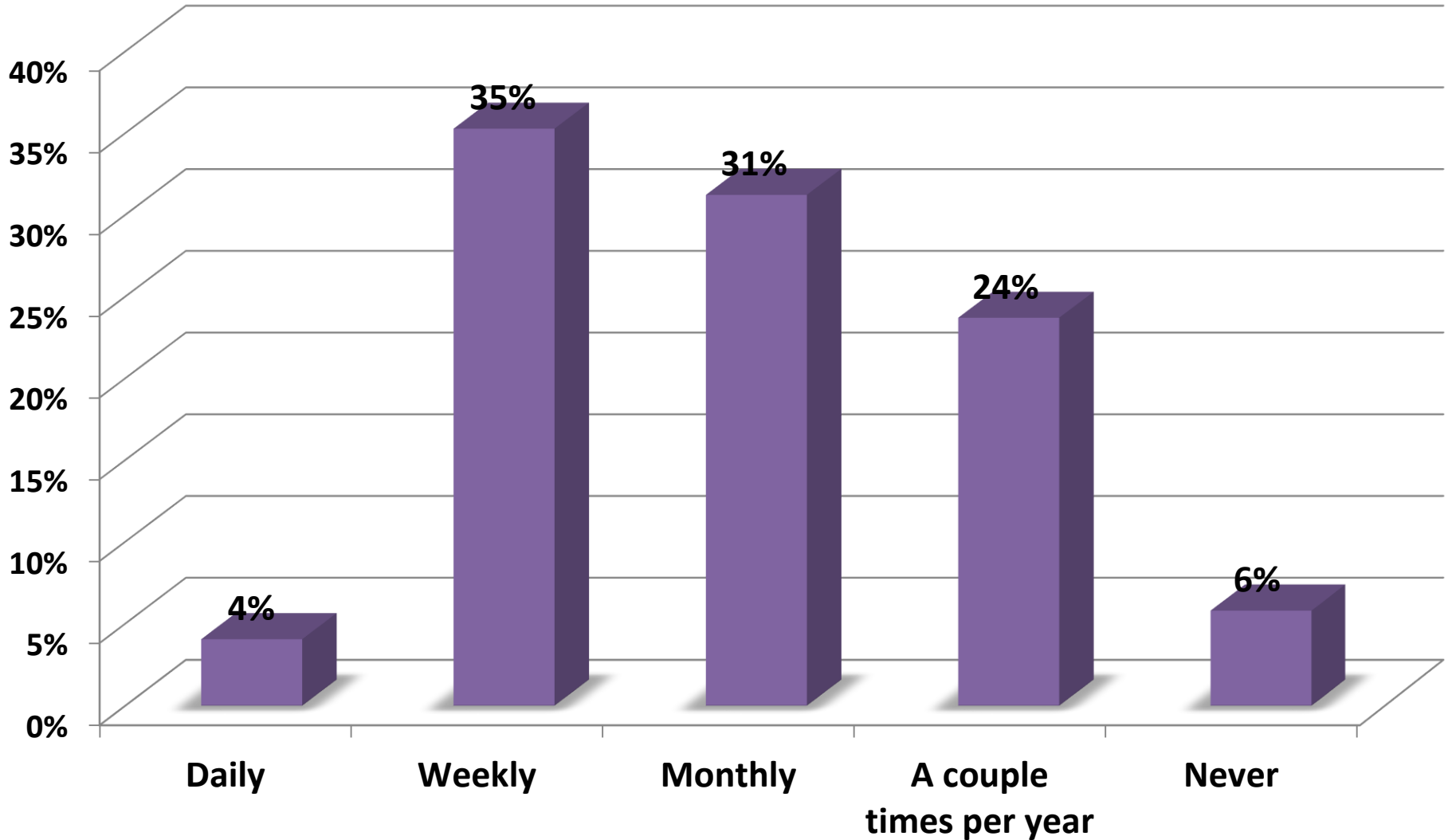

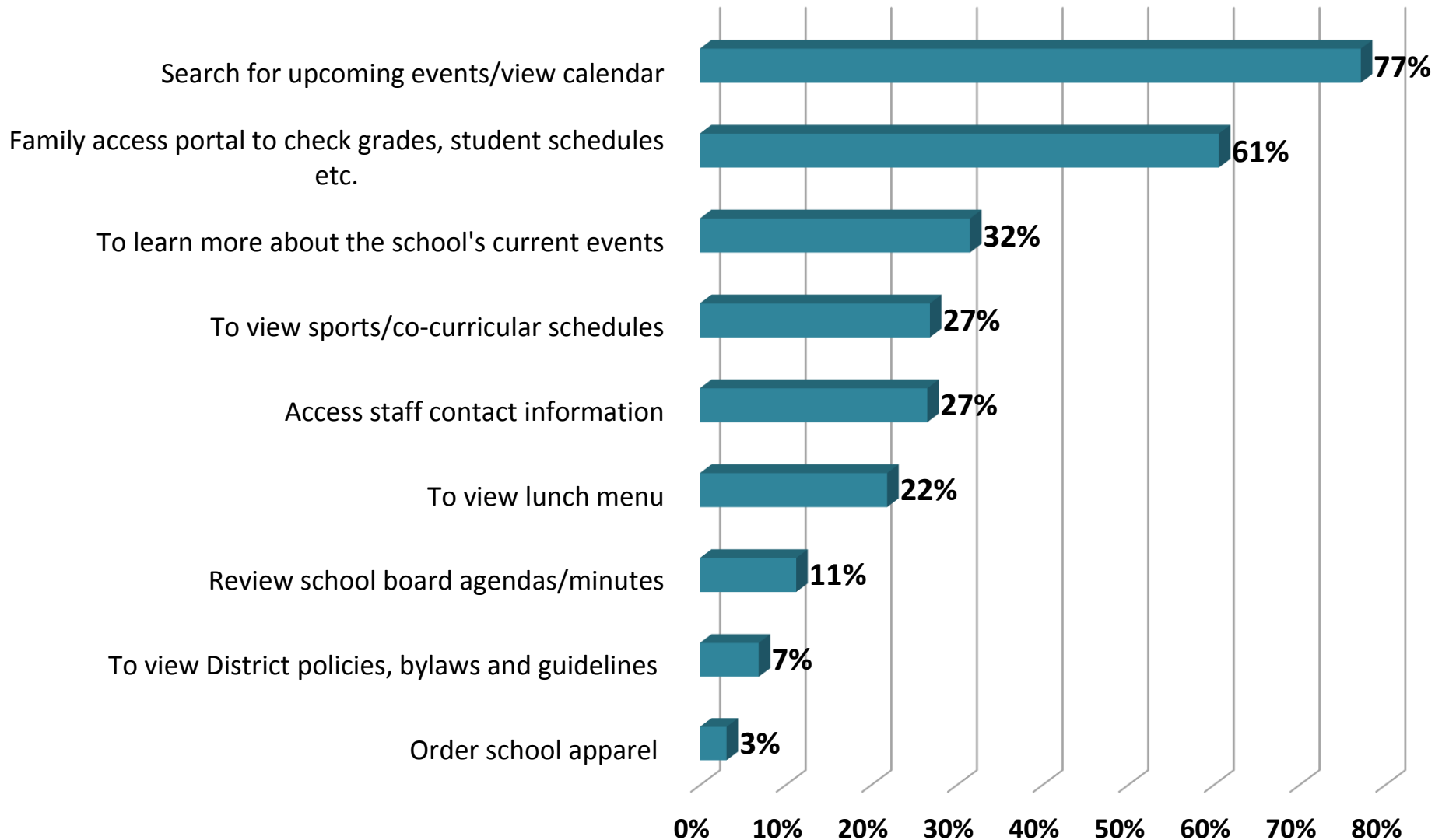

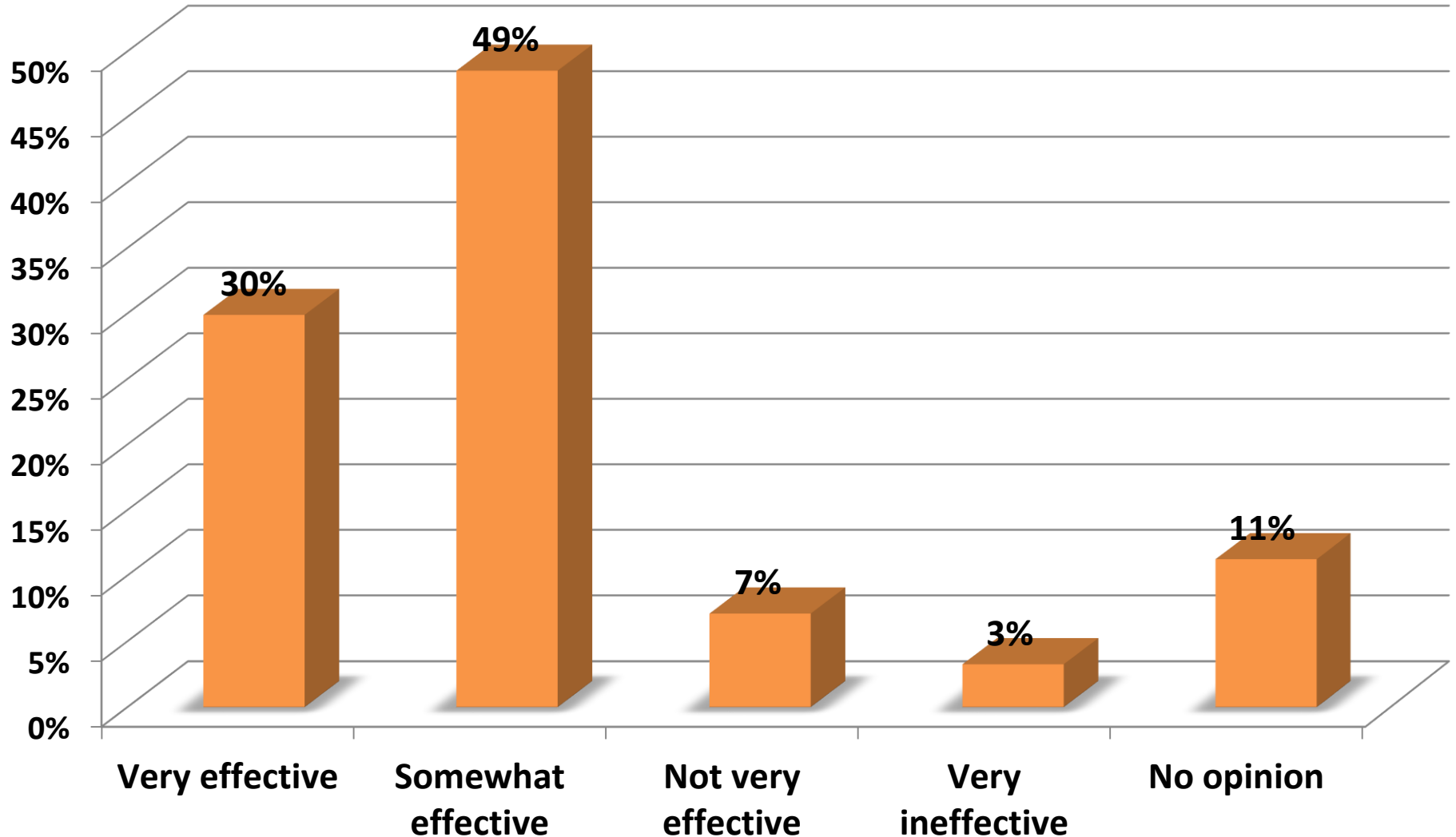
How often do you visit the District's website?

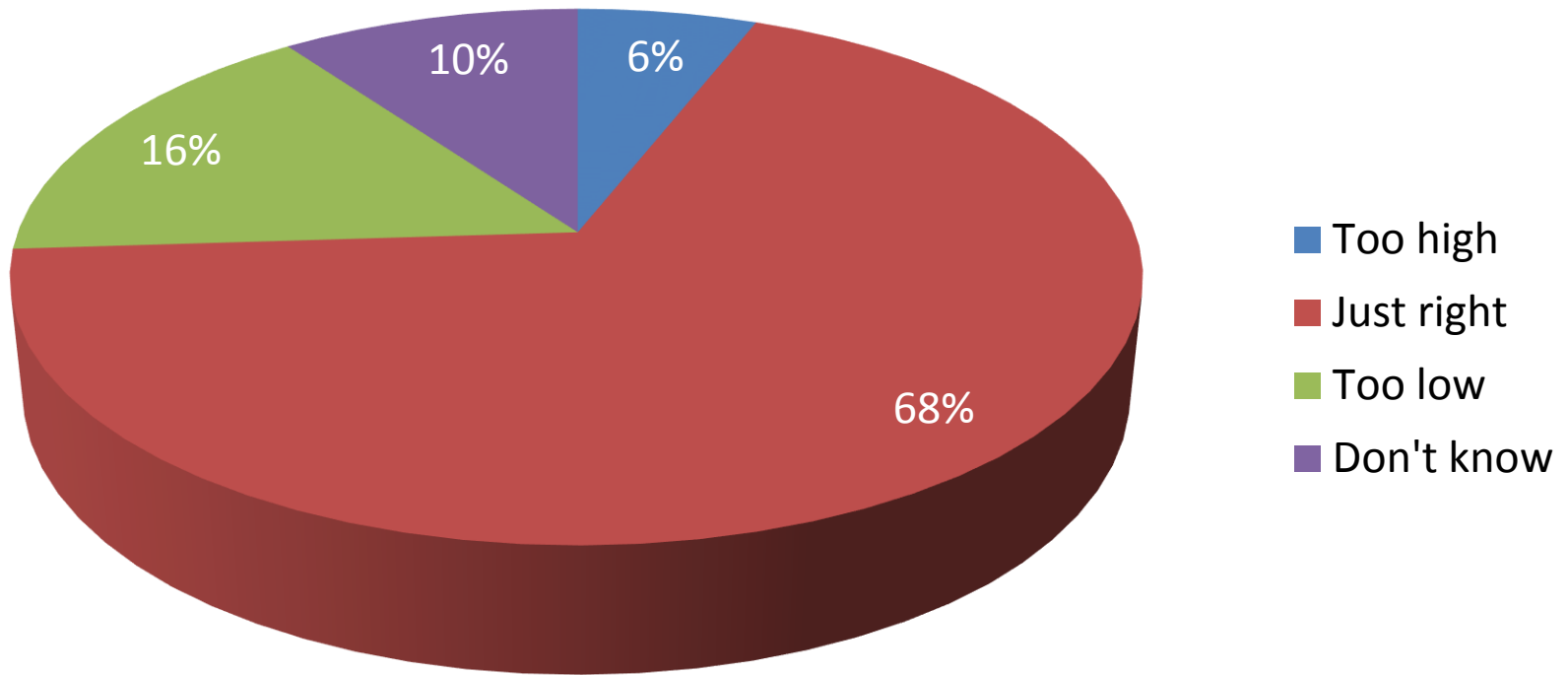

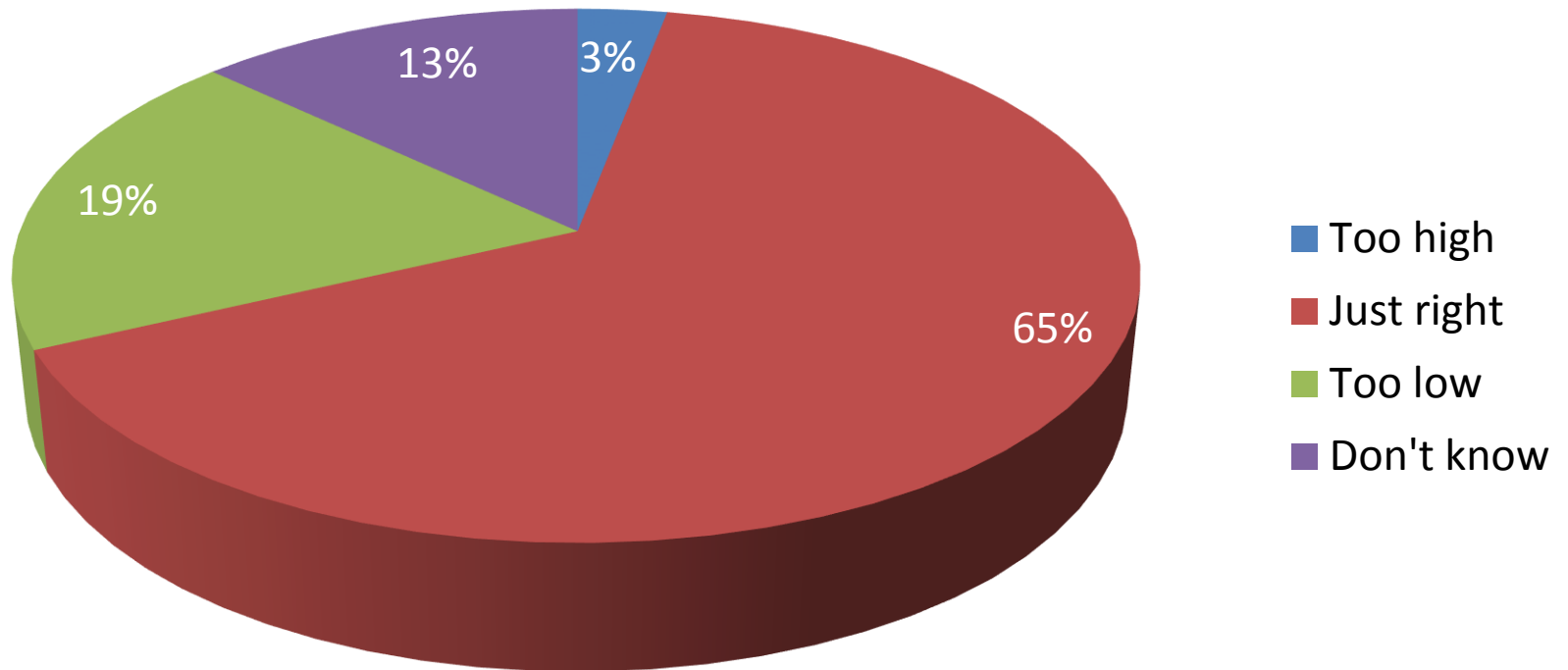

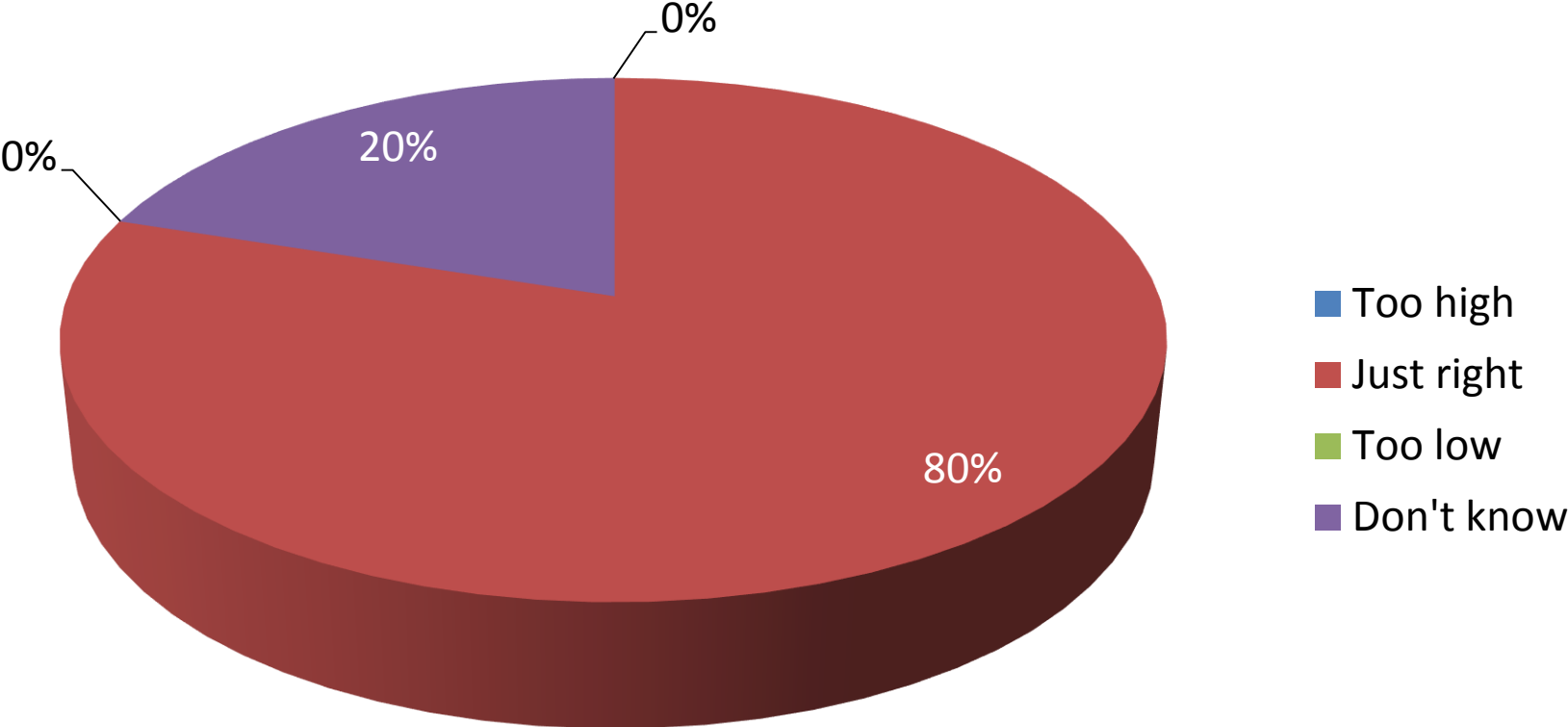

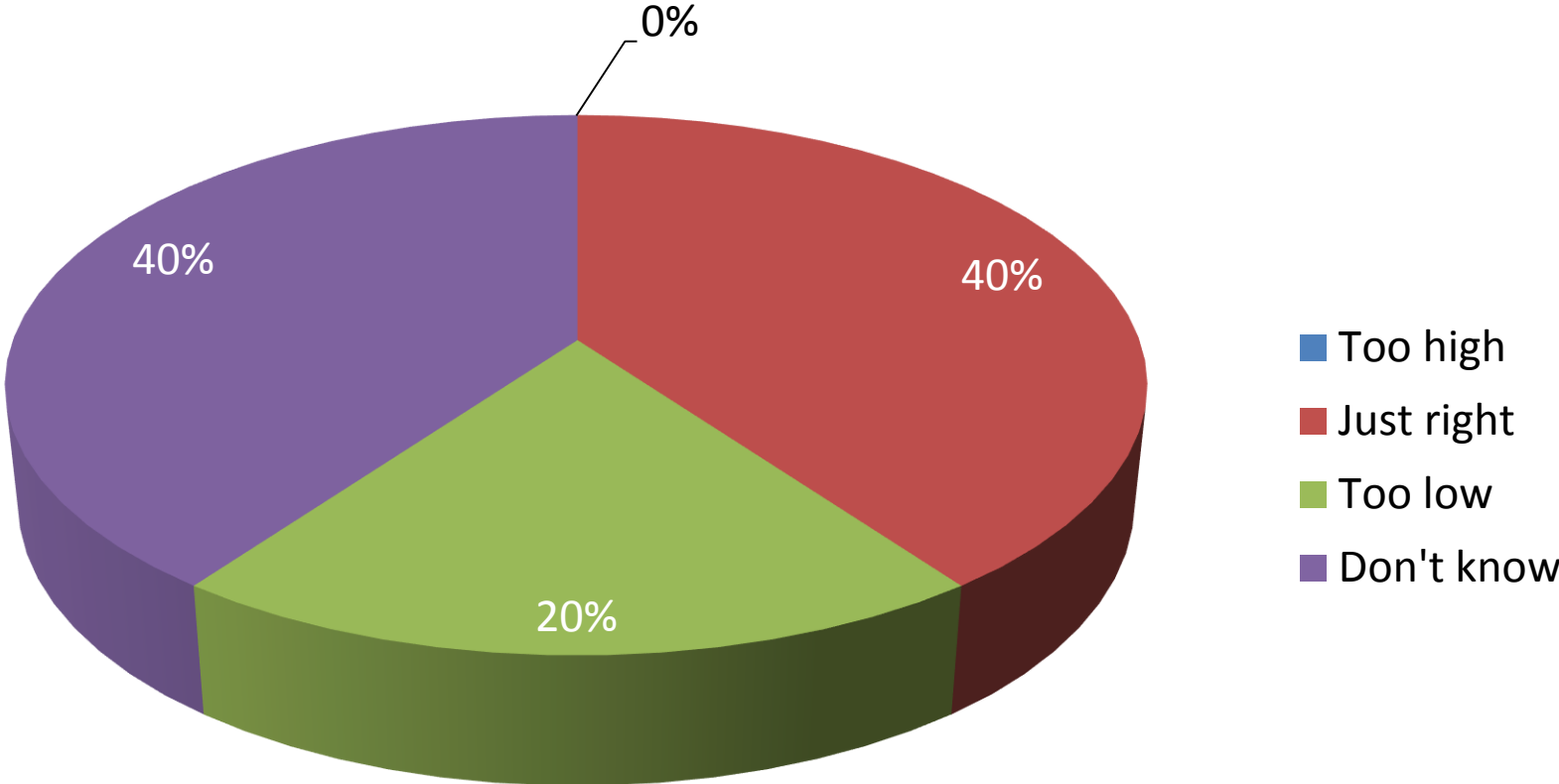

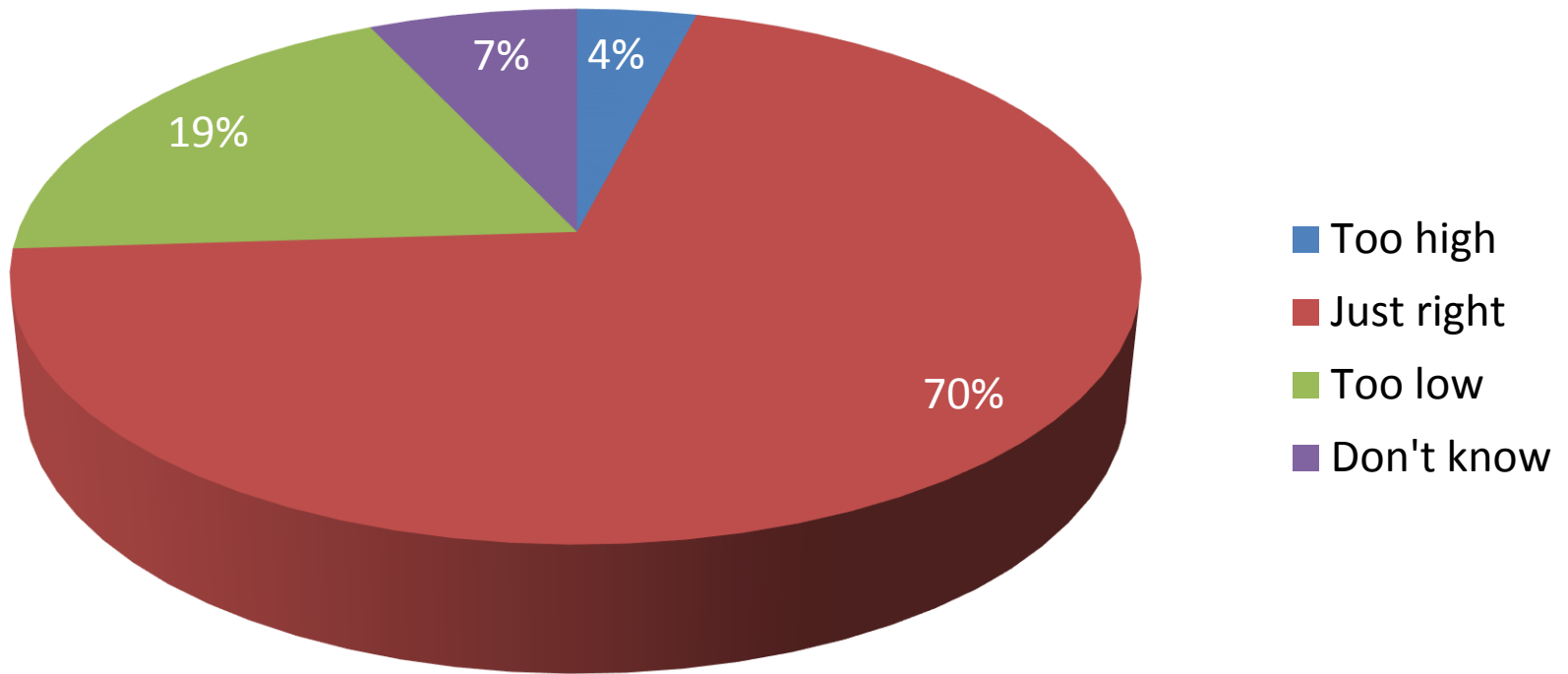

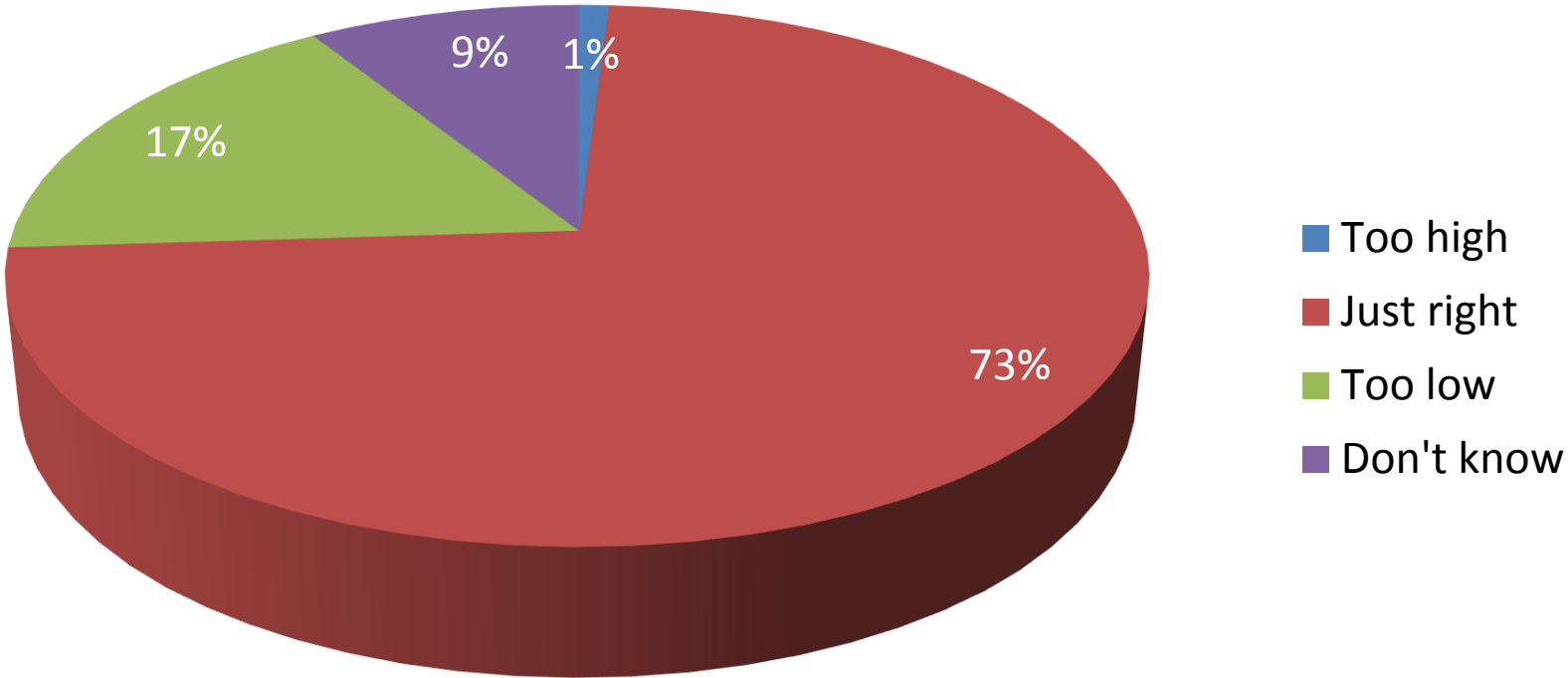

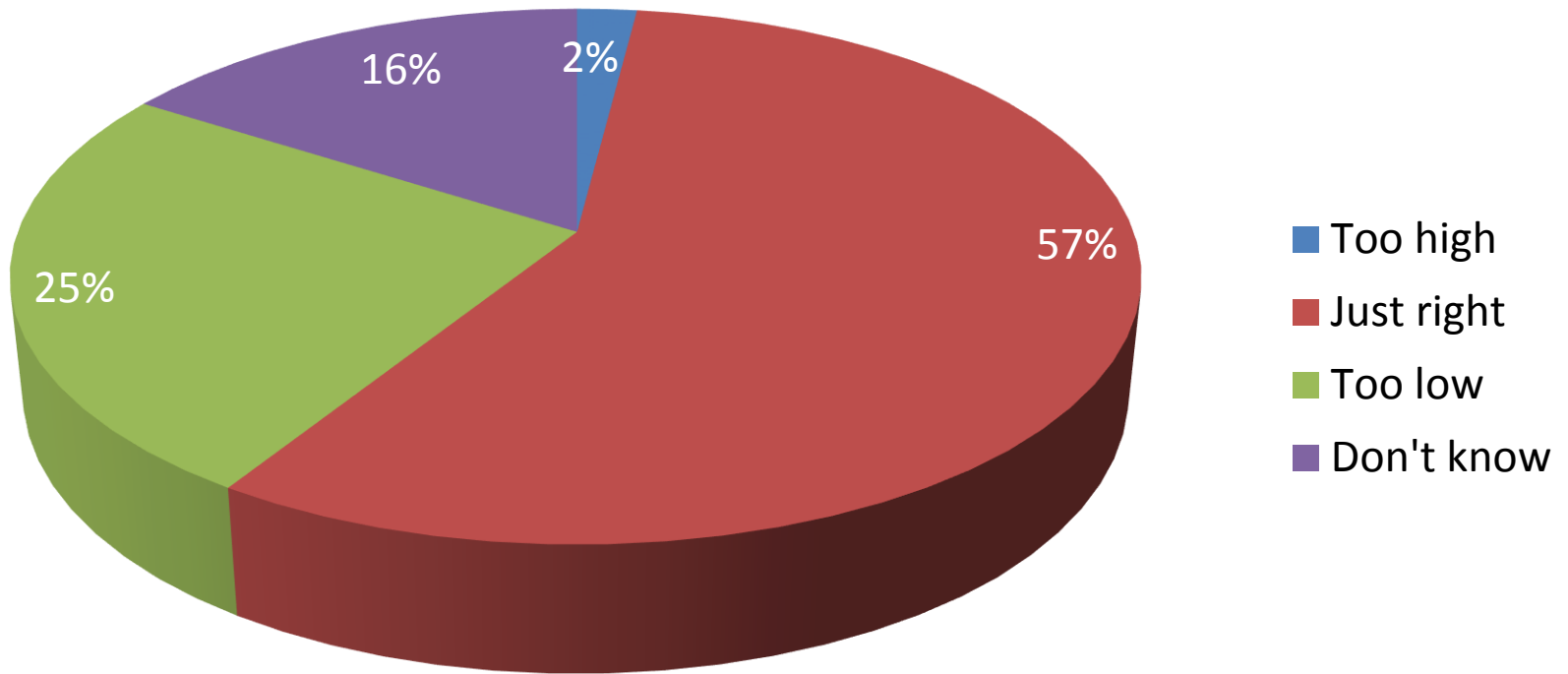

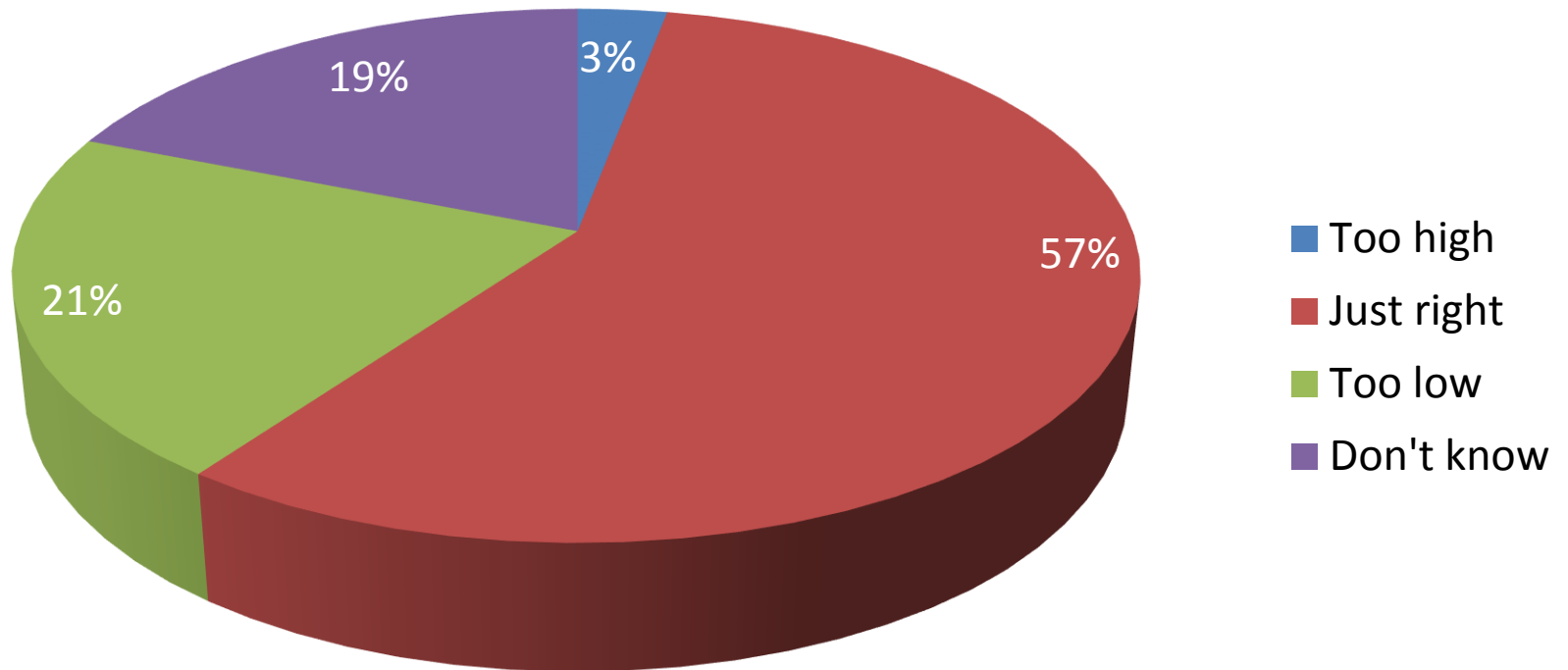

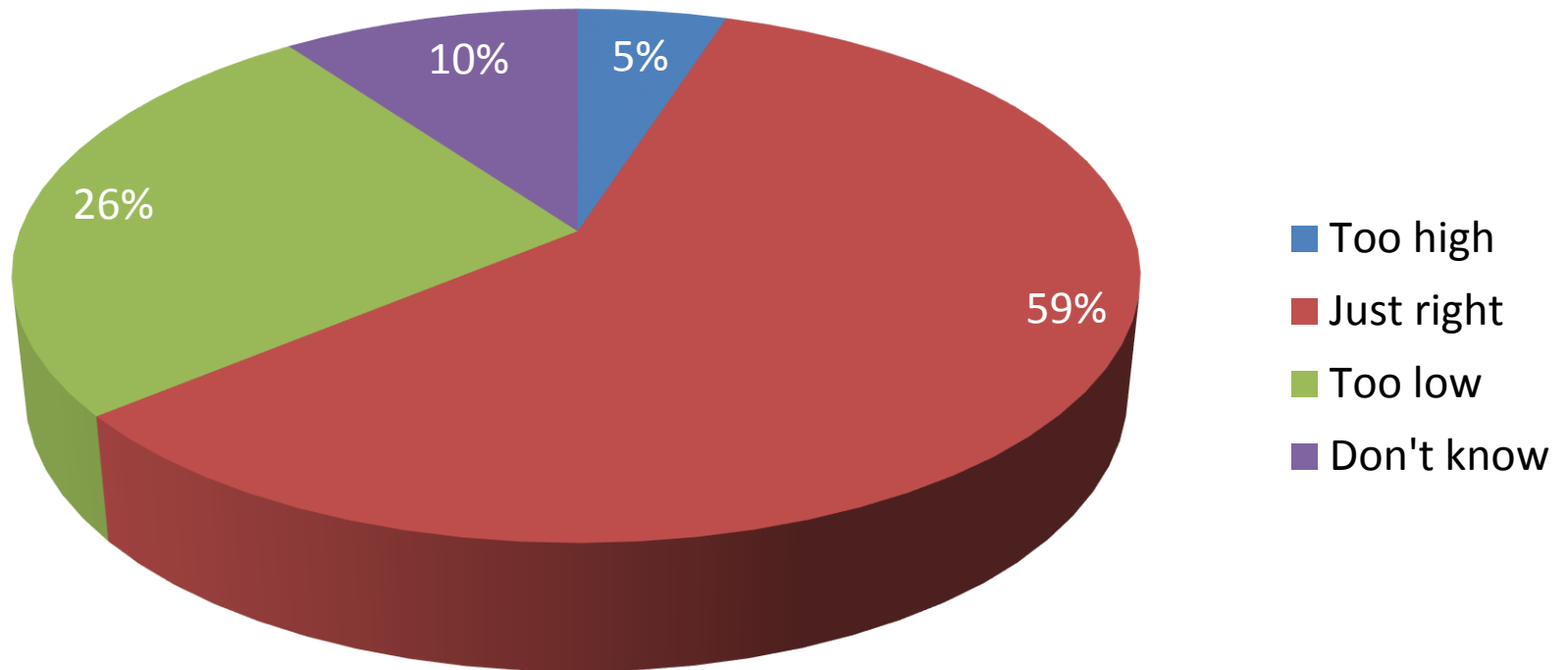

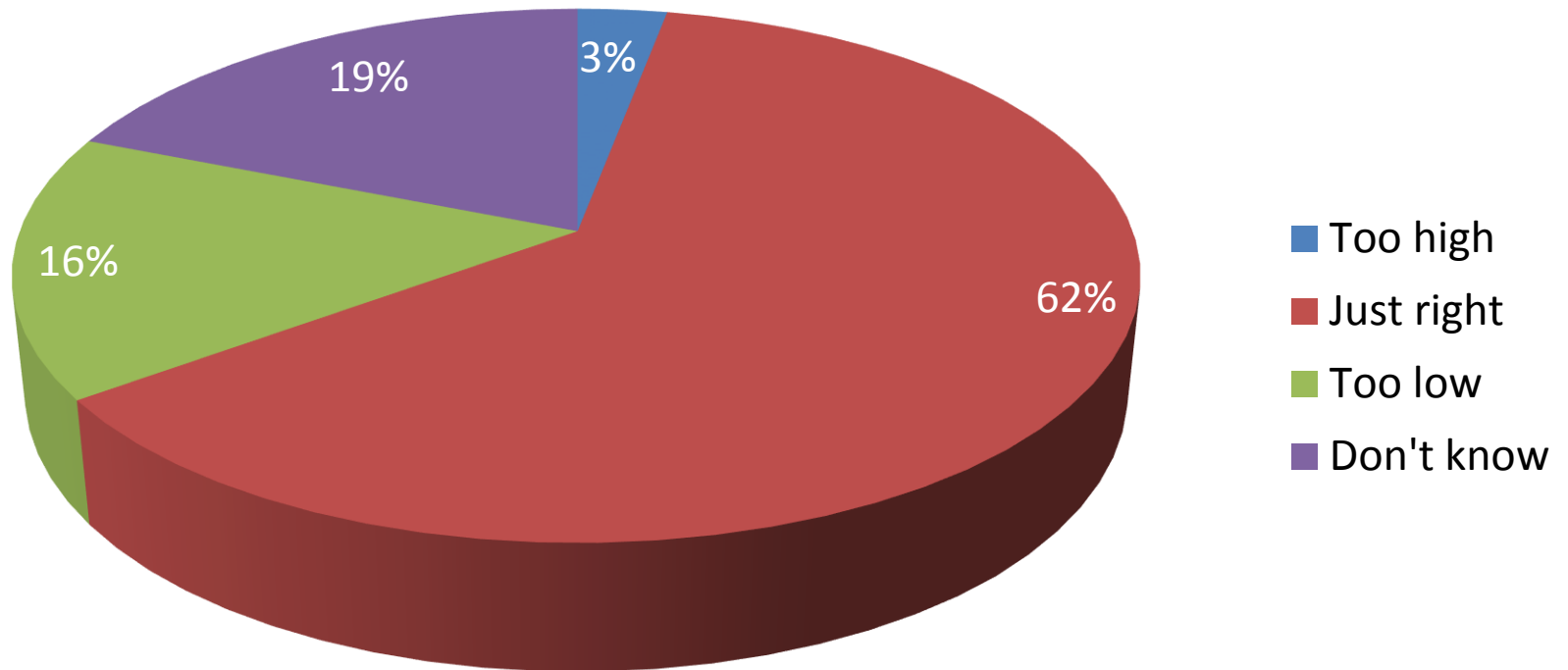

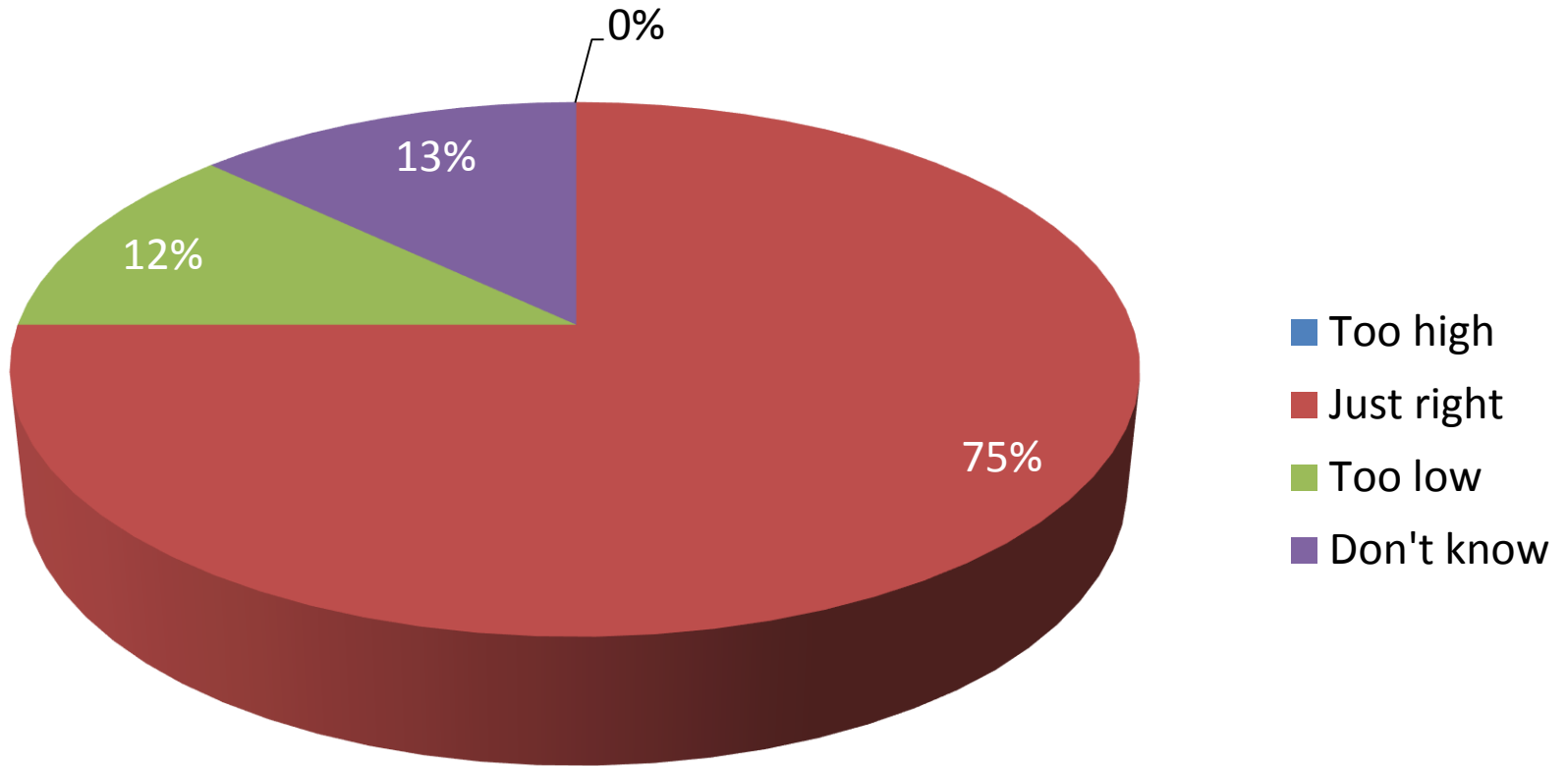

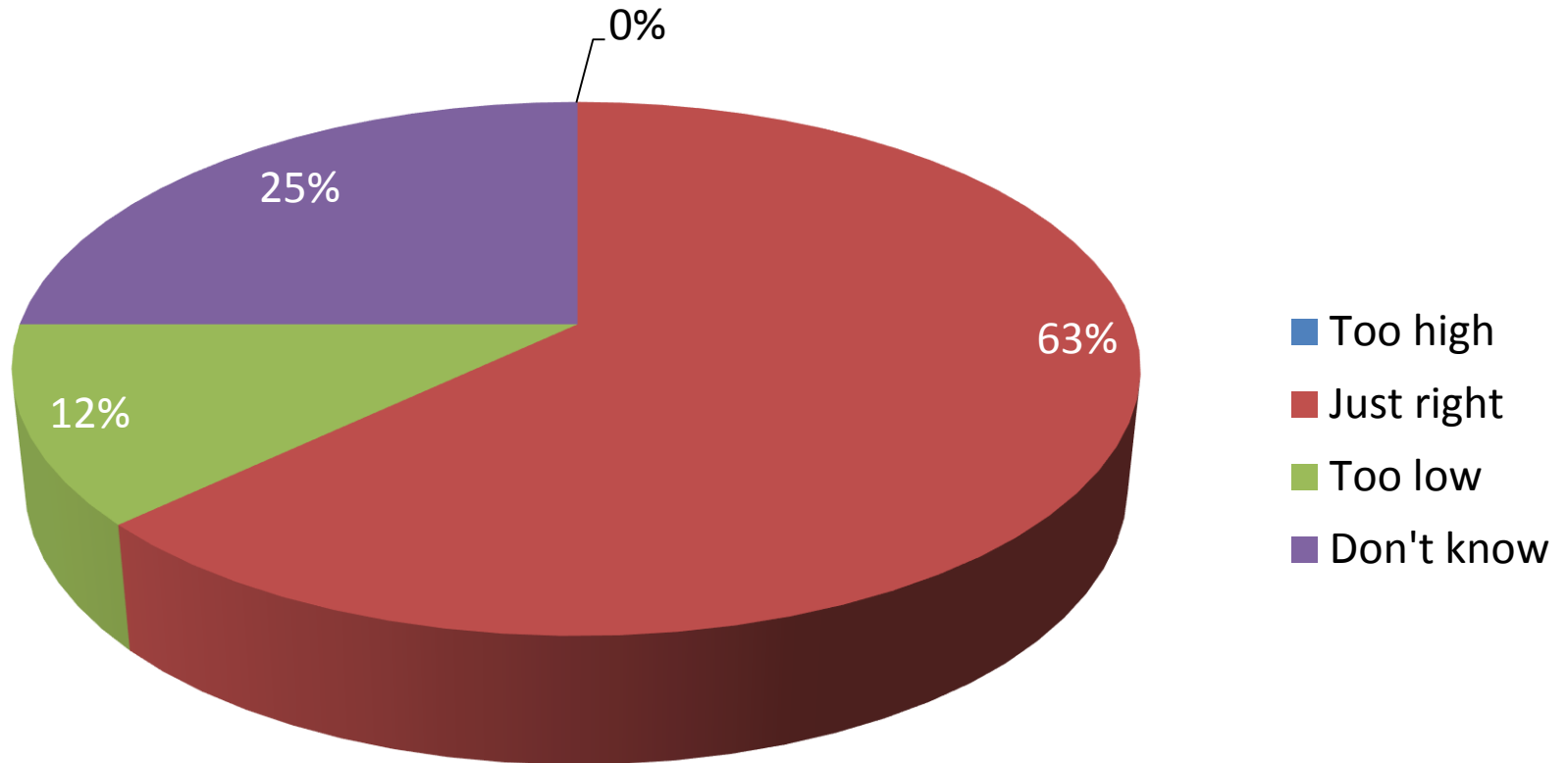

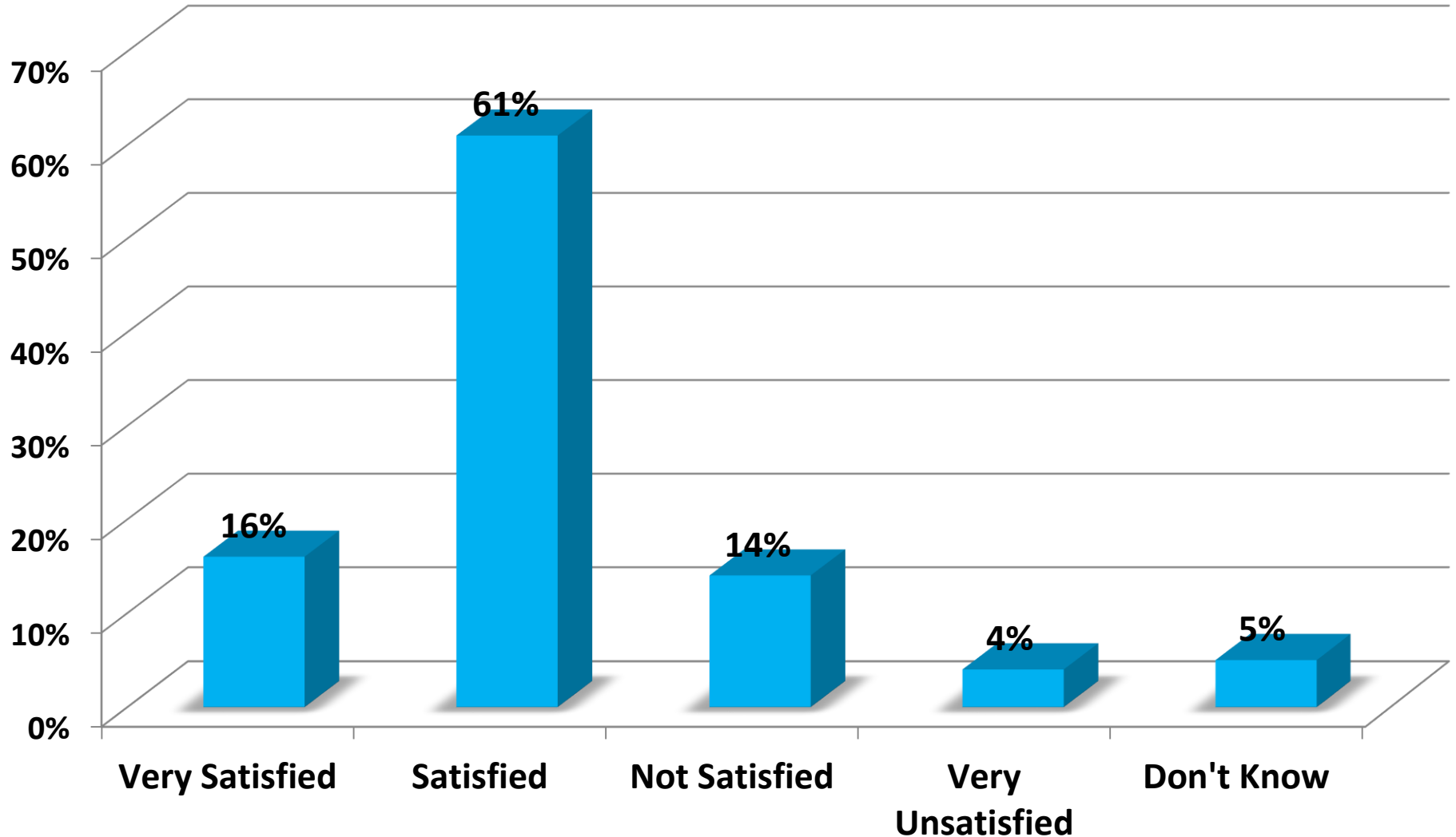


The overall use of technology at Alternative Education is:
