HOME OR HOSPITAL INSTRUCTION

Upon request from a parent or an adult student, home or hospital instruction <u>willshall</u> be provided to students who are unable to attend school for an estimated period of 4 weeks or more because of disability or illness. A written statement from a qualified medical practitioner verifying that the student will not be able to attend school for an estimated period of four weeks or more <u>willshall</u> accompany the request. The district <u>willshall</u> not pay for any costs incurred in securing the medical verification.
