WOODLAND SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 404 REDUCED EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM FOR 2018-19 RESOLUTION NO. 18-01

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has reviewed the recommendation of the Superintendent concerning the impact of class-schedule reorganization on the Career and Technical Education ("CTE") program at Woodland Middle School ("WMS"); and

WHEREAS, Woodland Public Schools ("District") has determined to adopt a revised class schedule at WMS for the 2018-19 school year, under which each school day will be divided into seven 50-minute periods during which electives will be offered during six of the periods, in contrast with the current schedule of six 61-minute periods during which electives are offered during five of the periods; and

WHEREAS, said revised class schedule at WMS is anticipated to increase the number and type of elective courses offered during the 2018-19 school year at WMS; and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent has determined that said schedule change and increased elective offerings make it infeasible to offer certain elective CTE courses taught by certificated employees at WMS who also teach at Woodland High School ("WHS"), specifically the Future Trades courses at WMS; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has received the recommendations of the Superintendent concerning the need for and the extent of a reduction in and reorganization of the educational program and certificated staff for the 2018-2019 school year to accommodate this schedule reorganization and assure that the number of full-time equivalent ("FTE") certificated employees does not exceed the number of positions needed to operate the educational program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of Woodland School District No. 404, Cowlitz County, Washington, as follows:

1. The educational program for the 2018-19 school year will be reduced by the following FTE or portion thereof positions at WMS:

.2 FTE CTE, Future Trades

2. The Superintendent is directed to take such action as may be required by contractual agreement or law to continue consulting with representatives of the certificated employees' bargaining unit and give appropriate notices to certificated employees to implement the above-described reduction and reorganization of the educational program and reduction in certificated staff, and to layoff, reduce, reassign, and transfer certificated staff members as required to implement this reduced program for the 2018-19 school year.
