In accordance with the original agreement of July 1, 2009 between Educational Opportunities for Children and Families (EOCF) and the Woodland School District, EOCF offers this letter of amendment to extend our Cooperative and Lease Agreement term for our Woodland Early Learning Center of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2018 to July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2028. The Cooperative and Lease Agreement for placement of the EOCF owned portable modular early learning preschool classroom is located on Woodland School District property at 600 Bozarth at 5th Woodland, Washington 98674.

All other terms and conditions of the original agreement and its subsequent amendments will remain in place. Notwithstanding any objection from your Board of Directors, I present this letter as an Amendment to the original agreement and request your acknowledgement.

2.0 TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT: This Agreement shall be effective from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2028, subject to review and renewal annually thereafter. PROVIDED that annually the District Board of Directors and EOCF approves continued participation in the Agreement and PROVIDED in no case shall this Agreement become effective before the date upon which all parties have signed the Agreement.

The general purpose of this agreement is to provide temporary shelter, in the event of an emergency situation for an early childhood population (0-3 and / or 3-5 years old) under care of Educational Opportunities for Children and Families agency (hereafter known as EOCF).

In consideration of the promises and conditions contained herein, the emergency service provider, **Woodland Primary School** and EOCF do mutually agree as follows:

- EOCF recognizes the fact that a disaster or emergency situation may require **Woodland Primary School** to provide shelter for children and staff of EOCF. In such an event, the first priority shall be to provide shelter to **Woodland Primary School** staff.

- The need for such shelter shall be declared by a fire department officer or administrator of EOCF, who will call to arrange for temporary shelter.
- Upon notification from EOCF for the needed sheltering and if **Woodland Primary School** needs requiring shelter have previously been met, will provide the appropriate amount of shelter, as requested by EOCF, at **Woodland Primary School, 600 Bozarth, Woodland, Washington 98674**.

- It shall be the responsibility and privilege of **Woodland Primary School** designee to determine the area to be used by EOCF on **Woodland Primary School** premises.

- Woodland Primary School** will not be responsible for providing any form of transportation of EOCF individuals to or from the shelter location.

- EOCF shall be responsible for all costs involved in the use of the facility for sheltering, including utility costs and other incidental expenses.
- EOCF shall be responsible for the supervision of EOCF staff and children on site.

This agreement may be terminated by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice.
