LEAVE SHARING

The district <u>willshall</u> establish and administer a leave sharing <u>program throughplan in</u> which eligible employees may donate excess leave for use by <u>an eligible recipienta staff member</u> who is suffering from, or has a relative or household member suffering from, an extraordinary or severe illness, injury, impairment, <u>or physical or mental condition; who is a victim of domestic violence, sexual assault, or stalking; who is sick or temporally disabled because of pregnancy disability; who is on parental leave; or who has been called to service in the uniform services or physical or mental condition.</u>

Such a program is intended to extend leave benefits to <u>an eligible recipient</u> a staff member who otherwise would have to take leave without pay or terminate his or her employment with the district.

The superintendent <u>or designee</u> is directed to <u>develop a procedure</u>establish procedures for <u>administering</u>staff members who earn personal holiday leave, staff members who accrue annual leave and sick leave and for staff members who do not earn annual leave but who accrue leave to be used for illnesses, injuries or emergencies to donate leave. The <u>superintendent</u> is directed to administer the leave sharing <u>programplan</u> in a manner consistent with state law and applicable collective bargaining agreements.


