The superintendent will arrange for health services to ~~for be provided to~~ all students. Such services will include but are not ~~be~~ limited to:-

1. ~~A.~~ — The maintenance of student health records;
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2. ~~B.~~ — The development of procedures at each building for the isolation and temporary care of students who become ill during the school day;
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3. ~~C.~~ — Consulting services of a licensed healthcare provider and/or Registered Nurse;
qualified health specialist;
4. ~~D.~~ — Vision (both distance and near) and hearing screening; and
- 1.5. — Immunization records and screening.
