STUDENT HEALTH

The superintendent will arrange for health services to <u>forbe provided to</u> all students. Such services will include but <u>are not be limited to:-</u>

<u>1.</u><u>A.</u>—The maintenance of student health records;

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- 2. B. The development of procedures at each building for the isolation and temporary care of students who become ill during the school day;
- <u>3.</u> <u>C.</u> Consulting services of a <u>licensed healthcare provider and/or Registered Nurse;</u> _<u>qualified health specialist;</u>
- 4. D. Vision (both distance and near) and hearing screening; and
- **<u>1.5.</u>** Immunization records and screening.
