Environmental Health and Safety

Ensuring an environment that is safe for students and staff is an important priority for the District. The Director of Facilities and Safety will be responsible for ensuring that school facilities comply with WAC 246-366 Primary and Secondary Schools, and WAC 246-366A Environmental health and safety standards for primary and secondary schools.

The Director may engage in environmental testing and remedial action as s/he determines appropriate to ensure a safe and healthy environment in District Facilities.

The Superintendent will develop procedures to ensure compliance with the WAC regulations and additional testing procedures.
