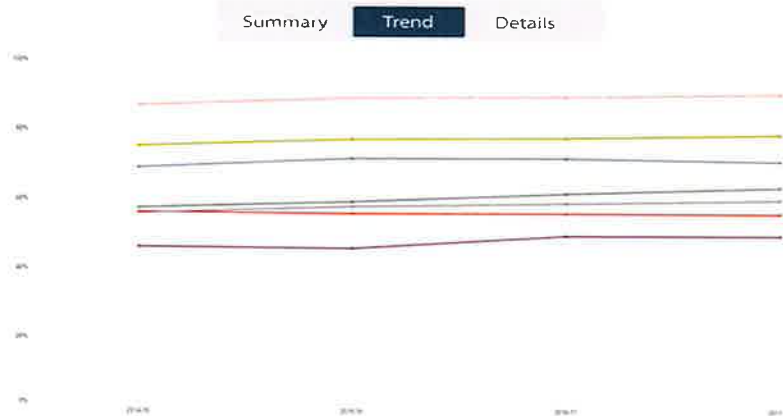

What percentage of students passed all their courses in ninth grade over time?

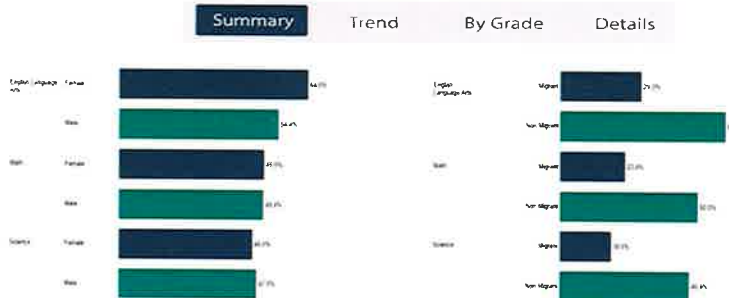
