

# CLC Work at the High School

Here is a summary of the work we have done to begin infusing the CLC standards into our daily routines here at the high school

1. We have renamed our advisory “CLC”.
  - a. We have seniors running through the seven different life skills (some from our list, others are additional). They are healthy living and cooking, financial awareness, survival skills, car skills, personal disposition awareness or Life Ready Skills and dispositions, sexual health education and résumé construction. Seniors rotate every four to five weeks.
  - b. Our 9th-11th graders are now in pathway groups and are exploring the various career options available in their pathway and doing research on additional schooling, cost, benefits, etc. Our seven pathways are: *Academy of Art and Humanities, Academy of Business and Computer Science, STEM Academy, Academy of Public Safety, Academy of Medical Occupations and Kinesiology, Academy of Skilled Trades and Academy of Family, Vocational, and Consumer Sciences.*
2. We released a Google slides presentation to be reviewed/viewed in each CLC during the month of February. 3. The other significant change has been we built our school three improvement goals around this document. We have one goal for each area
  - a. Goal #1 is about increasing student participation in extra and co-curricular events. (Careers goal)
  - b. Goal #2 is around getting 100% of our student “Life” ready by being clear on expectations and creating assessments. We also have made the decision to expand the community service hours for students to Juniors and Senior years. This will help them in meeting the 25-hour requirement. We may also include 9th and 10th grade years, but we are waiting to see how Naviance helps us track that information.
  - c. Goal #3 is to increase our percentage of students College Ready. As with the other two goals, we have action steps our staff is working on during our Monday morning PLC time.
4. We will be implementing Naviance next year, with the hope of a soft launch this Spring. We plan to take two of our current CLC instructors and put them in charge of the Naviance roll out and plan. Those two teachers are Jody Flanagan and Devon Fliss.
