Resolution 22-03

Concerning Covid 19 Vaccine Requirement

WHEREAS, Chapter 28A.320 RCW authorizes local school boards to govern their respective districts, including adopting, revising, and suspending local board policies; and,

WHEREAS, on February 29, 2020, Washington Governor Jay Inslee declared a state of emergency in all counties of our state under Chapters 38.08, 38.52, and 43.06 RCW, and directed implementation of the plans and procedures of the state's Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan in response to the novel coronavirus (COVID-19); and,

WHEREAS, it is the right of the individual to make health decisions related to one's own body and one's family; and,

WHEREAS, getting the Covid-19 vaccine is an acceptable and accessible choice for any student, parent, or staff member who so desires; and,

WHEREAS, a Covid-19 vaccine mandate would create an unreasonable administrative burden; and,

WHEREAS, the Woodland School District is providing multiple learning options for families based on their ability to decide what is right for them relative to managing their own health risk; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Woodland School Board strongly opposes making the Covid-19 vaccine required under WAC 246-105-030.
