

What did the committee look for?

- Materials with a robus scope and sequence the include
 - Phonemic Awareness
 - Phonics (decoding)
 - Vocabulary
 - Background Knowledge
 - Oral Language
 - Fluency
- Lessons that are systematic and move from least to most complex
- Materials that have ease of use for teachers and substitutes
- Materials that provide enough practice opportunities that won't require additional supplemental materials
