

School Safety Survey (11/10/22)


Do you feel safe when you come to school? 92 responses



On a scale of 1-5, how safe would you feel with your teachers, in a case of emergency? 92 responses




On a scale of 1-5, how safe do your peers make you feel on a day to day basis? 92 responses

Summary/Additional Information:

WHS ASB released the safety survey on Monday (11/7). The survey accumulated 93 participants and the survey was concluded Thursday (11/10) around 10:00. The survey was accessible through students' emails and the survey was announced to students through the bulletin and their emails. WHS ASB looked over the survey with Dr. Pearson and Mr. Uhlenkott on Tuesday (11/8) as most students typically respond to surveys relatively quickly. ASB and administrators are planning to possibly look into vape detectors for the bathrooms and a committee is being held to manage the dress code policy. The survey would normally be linked through the school board report, however due to wanting to get accurate survey results along with the process of creating the survey and publishing it for students, the survey was conducted separately from the board report. The survey was anonymous.
