## TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

Independent Contractor Status: The District and Contractor agree that the Contractor and Contractor's cmployec(s) and agent(s) are not employes of Woodland Public Schools. Contractor and Contractor's employee(s) and agent(s) shall provide the results required in this agreement as an independent contactor. Woodland Public Schools shatl not control or supervise the manner in which this agreement is perfomed. Contractor shall be responsible for paying and withholding unemployment, workers compensation and employment taxes if applicable For Contactor and Contractor's employees(s).

Indemnification: The Contractor shall protect indemity and save the District harmless from and agamst any damage, cost or liability for mifury or death to persons of damage to or destruction of property arising out of work performed under this contract. except for the sole negligence of the District.
Termination: This agreement may be terminated by Woodland Public Schools with or without reason upon written notification thereof to the Contractor. In the event of termination by Woodland Public Sehools. Contractor shall be entitled to an equitable proration of the total compensation provided herein for uncompensated services which have been performed as of termination and to the reimbursement of expenses incurred as of temumation, but solely to the extent such expenses are reimbursable pursuant to the provisions of the agreement. Contractor may terminate this agreement if the District violates the terms of this agreement and fails to remedy the violation within 30 days of receiving written notice from the Contractor.

Agreement Alterations: This written agreement constitutes the mutual agrecment of the Contractor and the District in whole. No alteration or variation of this agreement unless made in writing between the parties hereto. shall be binding. In the event any elause within this contract should be declared intalid, the remaining portions of the contract will continue to remain in force.


#### Abstract

Assignment and Sub-grants. Contractor shall not subcontract or assign any of its rights or obligations under this Agreement without the signed written consent of the District. If the District agrees in writing to allow Contractor to subcontract or assign any of Contractor's obligations, assignees or subcontractor shall comply with all the terms in this Agreement and Contractor shall be responsible for ensuring its assignees or subcontractors compliance.

Insurance: Contactor shatl be responsible for their own insurance. Contractors who will be providing difect services to students or the general public on the school district's behalf are required to provide a Centificate of Insutance evidencing Commercial Gencral Liabifity insustuce arillen on an occurence basis with limits no less than $\$ 1,000.000$ combined single limit per oceurrence for personal injury. bodily injury and property damage.

Applicable Law: This agreement shall be groverned by all Washington State and Federal laws including RCWs 28A.400.303. 28A-400. 330, 9A.32, 9A.36, 9A.42, 9A-44, 9A, 64, 030, 9A. 88 or any other curem lams polative to record checks, crimes agrainst children, or conditions required for working with children.

Pursuant to RCW 28.A.400.303. any contractor who will have unsupervised aceess to children under this agreement shall be required to have successful completion of a background check through the Washington State Patrol Criminal Identification System, under RCW $43-43.830-834$, RCW 10.97.30 \& .50, and through the Federal Burcaut of Investigation prior to contracting with the District and prior to unsupervised access to children. Upon approval by the Purchasing Department. when necessary, contracts may commence on a conditional basis pending completion of the background checks. Contrater shall not uilize any employec (or subcontractor or their employess) an the District site or allow any contact between sehool children and any employee when an employee has pled guity to or been convicted of any fetony crime involving the physical neglect of a child under Chapter 9A.42 RCW. the physical injury or death of a child under Chapter 9A, 32 or 9 A .36 RCW (except motor velicle violations under Chapter $4(6,6)$ RCW ). sexual exploitalion of a child under Chapter 9A. 44 RCW where a minor is the victim, promoting prostitution ol a miner under Chapter 9A.88 RCW, the sate or purchase of a minor child under 9A. 64.030 RCW. or violation of similar laws of another jurisdiction. Any failure to comply with this seetion shall be grounds for the District to immediately terminate this agreement.

Any claim, suit, or other legal action pertaining to this Contract shatl be brought under the laws of the Sate of Washingtun in Cowlitz County, Washington.

Contidentiality: In providing services under this Contract, Conlractor may have access to personally identiffable education records ancl confidential infomation regarding District students or stalt (collectively refored to ats "Confidential Infornation"). Contratior agrees that they will maintain the confidentiality of Confidential Infonnation. The use or disclosure of any Confidential Information for any purpose nol directly connected to Conntator's servies under this Contract is strietly prohibited except where reguired or anthorized by law.

Diserimination: The Contractor assures the District that the Contractor complies with all stace and federal guidelines and or regulations and does not discriminate on the basis of race. color, national origin. yender, age, veteran's status, disability, or any oller protected group under the law.

Invoice/W-9: Contractor will provide an original invoice(s) Cor services performed prior to payment. Contractor will also provide a completed IRS Form W-9, to be provided to the District at the execution of his contract andion in the erent the IRS reteases a revised form.

Pavment: Payments are made monthly through the Business Services Office. The District will not prepay for services. The total amount the Distriet will pay is inclusive of afl expenses unless agreed upon in this contract and pre-approved by the Distriet. Invoiees should be submitted to the address below and must be approved by The Disirict prior to payment being issued. Contractor must notify the District if heishe intends to pich up their payment, otherwise the payment will be mailed to the address provided on the W-9 tomm. Payments to Contractor will, where appropriate. be subject to !099 teporting.

Conflict of Interess: C'urrent employees of Woodland Public Schools may not enter into a contractual scrvices agrement with the District, The Contractor shall not receive compensation from more than one political subdivision of the state of Washington for the same hours worked. If the Contractor is providing services to another organization that are the same as the services Contractor is providing to the District and is being compensated by the other organization, the amount the District paid for the services constitute an Overpayment, which shall be withheld from future payments or reimbursed to the District.

Records: Contractor shall maintain books, records, documents, data and other evidence compiled and related to the performance of the services required in this Agreement and any data that substantiates the payment amount requested, including receipts for incurred expenses. The records shall be retained for a period of seven (7) years following completion of the Agreement. At no additional cost, Consultant shall provide the District access to and copies of any records.

Intellectual Property: Any materials Contractor produces in connection with this Agreement shall be considered "works made for hire" as defined by the United States Copyright Act and will be owned by the District. District will be considered the author of such materials. To the extent materials being produced in connection with this Agreement are found not to be "works made for hire," Contractor hereby irrevocably assigns all right, title and interest in such materials, including intellectual property rights, to District effective from the moment of creation. Consultant shall not use any materials produced for District in connection with this Agreement without obtaining the District's prior written consent.
Waiver: No provision in this Agreement or the right to receive reasonable performance of any obligation in this Agreement shall be deemed waived.
Contractor's Signature: Contractor and Contractor's employee(s) or agent(s) signing this document certifies that he/she is the person duly qualified and authorized to bind the Contractor so identified to the foregoing agreement and, under penalty of perjury, certifies that all information provided including the federal tax identification or social security account number is truthful and correct.
