In consideration of the promises and conditions contained herein, the emergency service provider, Columbia Elementary School and EOCF do mutually agree as follows: (Alternate site provider name) EOCF recognizes the fact that a disaster or emergency situation may require Columbia Elementary School to provide shelter for children and staff of EOCF. In (Alternate site provider name) such an event, the first priority shall be to provide shelter **Columbia Elementary School** staff. (Alternate site provider name) The need for such shelter shall be declared by a fire department officer or administrator of EOCF, who will call to arrange for temporary shelter. Upon notification from EOCF for the needed sheltering and 3. Columbia Elementary School (Alternate site provider name)'s needs requiring shelter have previously been met, will provide the appropriate amount of shelter, as requested EOCF. at Columbia Elementary School, 600 Bozarth, Woodland, Washington 98674 (Alternate site provider), (site, and location and phone number) It shall be the responsibility and privilege of Columbia Elementary School designee to determine (Alternate site provider's name) the area to be used by EOCF premises. on **Columbia Elementary School** (Alternate site provider's name)

- 8. EOCF shall be responsible for any damages that result from negligence by EOCF staff and children.

HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT: EOCF agrees and covenants to indemnify, defend, and save harmless
