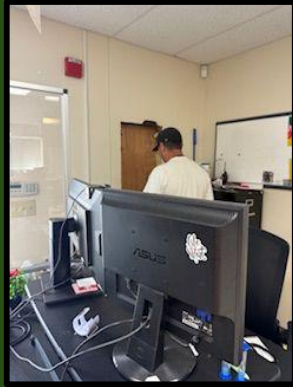
- Painted CES principal's office

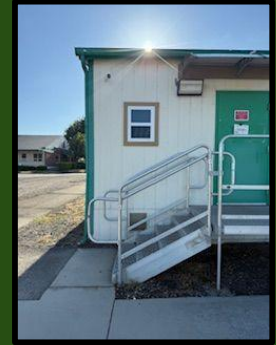

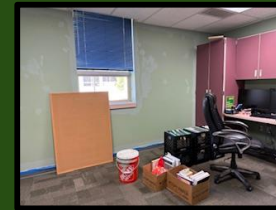
Installed new batteries for the scrubber at NFES

  - Scoreboards
  - Press boxes
  - Storage areas
  - Building mounted signs
- Strip and refinish floors
- Touch up paint and minor scuffs
- Clean interior and exterior windows

- Vacuum and shampoo carpets
- Speciality clean for turnover:
  - Principal and vice-principal's offices at WMS
  - Principal's office at CES



# Custodial Crew ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

- Emptied all classrooms to prepare for deep cleaning
- Steam-cleaned all carpets through the district
- Prepped, stripped, and refinished all floors that needed it
- Deep cleaning of all classrooms, office spaces, common spaces

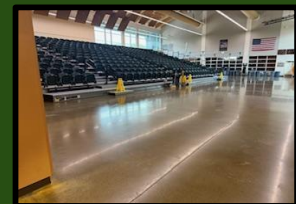

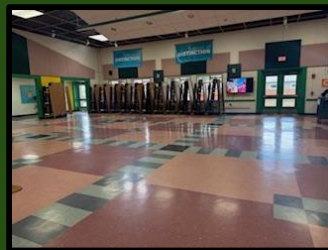

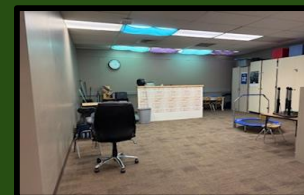

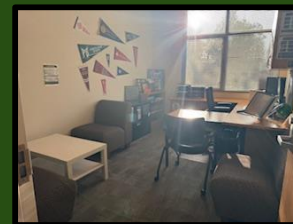

- Beds and lawns
  - Weed
  - Edge
  - Resurface (bark dust)

- Pressure wash exterior greenhouse walls and roof
- Weekly lawn mowing of all fields



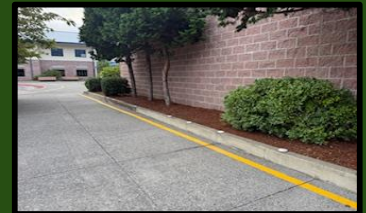
# Grounds Crew Accomplishments

- Aerial lift certified on both the scissor lift and boom lift

- Repair of irrigation system at the high school after a leak was detected

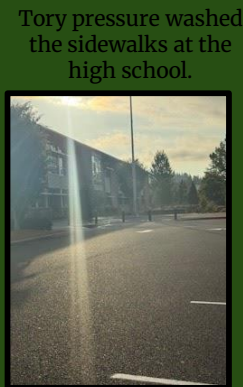
