1. EOCF recognizes the fact that a disaster or emergency situation may require

4. It shall be the responsibility and privilege of **Columbia Elementary School** designee to determine

5. **Columbia Elementary School** will not be responsible for providing any form of transportation of EOCF

individuals to or from the shelter location unless prior arrangements have been communicated by both parties.

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6. EOCF shall be responsible for all costs involved in the use of the facility for sheltering, including utility costs and other incidental expenses.
7. EOCF shall be responsible for the supervision of EOCF staff and children on site.
8. EOCF shall be responsible for any damages that result from negligence by EOCF staff and children.

HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT: EOCF agrees and covenants to indemnify, defend, and save harmless

This agreement shall remain in effect for a period of one (1) year with the effective date of **July 1, 2026** and may be renewed annually upon written request by EOCF.
